



The TV is packaged with the TV stand separated from the cabinet. To setup the TV table stand, please carry out the installation according to the instructions below.











Side Keypad and Front Panel

Keypad Buttons

If you cannot locate your remote, you can use the side keypad buttons on your TV to operate many TV features.



INPUT: Displays the Source Select List. **MENU:** Displays the TV Main Menu.

CHA: Scans up through the channel list. In the TV menu system, it acts like the up arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.

CH▼: Scans down through the channel list. In the TV menu system, it acts like the down arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.

VOL+: Increases the volume. In the TV menu system, it acts like the right arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.


VOL-: Decreases the volume. In the TV menu system, it acts like the left arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.

POWER (也): Turns the TV on and off.

Front Panel

About remote control working distance and angle, see next page.

Power/Standby Indicator: Blue and red dual-color LED. It shows red when the TV is turned off and blue when turned on. Remote Control Sensor: Remote control IR sensor, which receives infrared ray sent by remote control.





Remote Control Instructions

Inserting Batteries in the Remote

- Remove the battery compartment cover from the back of the remote control by lifting the cover.
- Insert 2AAA batteries ,making sure the polarities(+and-) are aligned correctly.
- 3. Replace the cover.







If the remote control does not work, check these points:

- Are the polarities (+, -) correct?
- · Are the batteries worn out?
- Is there an AC power failure?
- · Is the power cord plugged in?
- Is there any interference or block near the remote control sensor?


CAUTION:

- Used batteries should be recycled.
- · Keep out of children's reach.

- Change both the batteries at the same time.
- When not using the remote control for a long time, remove the batteries from the unit.

Learning about Remote Control



POWER: Press the TV on and standby.

MUTE: Press to mutes the sound.

NUMBER: Numeric buttons for direct channel access.

-/--: Call up the program table.

: go back to the last viewed channel.

AUDIO: Switch the audio channel in DVD or multimedia mode.

FAV: Press to display the favorite channel list which you stored before.

FAV+ or FAV-: Scans up or down through the current favorite channel list.

CHANNEL "+" "-": Press to change the TV channels.

VOL "+" "-": Press to increase or decrease the volume.

P.MODE: Press to select the picture mode.

S.MODE: Press to select the sound mode.

SLEEP: Press to select a preset time interval for automatic shut off.

ASPECT: Aspect Ratio

INPUT: Accesses the available input channels, Use the arrows to highlight options, and press OK to select.

INFO: Displays the current input information.

▼► ▲ ▼: Use to select on-screen menu items and change menu values.

OK: Enter and conform button.

MENU: Press to display the OSD menu.

EXIT: Exit the menu

TEXT: To enter Teletext mode

INDEX: To display the index page

MIX: TV and TXT picture are mixed together in transparent background.

REVEAL: Teletext mode-To reveal or hide the hidden words.

HOLD: Teletext mode-Hold current page which is displayed.

SUBPAGE: Sub coded page access.

SIZE: Change the size of display in Teletext mode.





- Press ▲/▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the Picture menu, and then press ENTER button or ▶ button to enter.
- Press ◄/► button to adjust or press ▲/▼ button to select. And press ENTER button to select the sub menu.
- After finishing your adjustment, press MENU button to save and return back to the previous menu, and press EXIT button to exit the entire menu.

Picture Mode

Press ▲/▼ button to select Picture Mode, then press **ENTER** button to enter and press **◄/►** button to select,

You only can change the value of brightness, contrast, sharpness, color, when the picture is in User mode.

TIPS: You can press **P-MODE** button on the remoter control again and again to change the picture mode directly.

Picture Mode Standard

Contrast

Press ▲/▼ button to select Contrast, then press **ENTER** button to enter and press **◄/▶** button to adjust. Then press **MENU** button to return back the previous menu directly.

Brightness

Press ▲/▼ button to select Brightness, then press **ENTER** button to enter and press **◄/►** button to adjust. Then press **MENU** button to return back the previous menu directly.

Colour

Press ▲/▼ button to select Colour, then press ENTER button to enter and press ◄/► button to adjust. Then press MENU button to return back the previous menu directly.

Tint

Press ▲/▼ button to select Tint, then press **ENTER** button to enter and press **◄/►** button to adjust. Then press **MENU** button to return back the previous menu directly.

Sharpness

Press ▲/▼ button to select Sharpness, then press **ENTER** button to enter and press **◄/►** button to adjust. Then press **MENU** button to return back the previous menu directly.

Contrast Booster



Press ▲/▼ button to select Bass, then press ENTER or ▶ button to enter and press ◄/▶ button to adjust. It can only be adjusted under user mode. Then press MENU button to return

back the previous menu directly.

Treble

Press ▲/▼ button to select **Treble**, then press **ENTER** button to enter and press **◄/►** button to adjust. It can only be adjusted under user mode Then press **MENU** button to return back the previous menu directly.

Balance



Auto Tuning

Press ▲/▼ button to select **Auto Tuning**, and then press **ENTER** button to enter (When the System Lock is on, please input the PIN code to unlock).

Select to open the auto searching page, and press Enter button to start the scan.






Press number keys and direction keys, user can set the channel, date, start time, repeat, operation and record length information on this menu.

- Press ▲/▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the PREFERENCES menu, then press ENTER to enter.
- 2. Press **◄/**▶ button to adjust or press **▲/**▼ button to select.
- 3. After finishing your adjustment, press **MENU** button to save and return back to the previous menu and press **EXIT** button to exit the entire menu.

Menu Language





How to use Record

The HK-RTD2957support two type to record:

- A . Direct Record
- B、Subscribe Record

Direct Record.

1. In the DTV source, you can start record function by press the "REC" key while program playing. Before that, you have to make sure the USB storage device is inserted and the device checking and Initialization is done.

If you press "REC" key when there's no USB storage device inserted, the promp window will appear as follow.



If you press "REC" key during the device checking and Initialization, the promp window will show black screen about 2s.when the TV is recording, it will appear the recording menu.



2. After record started, you can select the items for the founctions:

PLAY/PAUSE/STOP/AB/FF/FR/PRVE/NEXT. You can seen the detail info by the record menu.





PLAY/PAUSE: you can set the play mode PLAY/PAUSE;


STOP: you can stop the recording, it will appear the menu for check whether to stop the recording.

AB: you can set two point for play the record file from A to B.

FF/FR: you can set the play mode FF/FR;

PRVE/NEXT: you can play the record file to PRVE/NEXT 30s.

- 3. After record started, you can press the button of PLAY/FF/RPRVE/NEXT on the RC ,you can play the record file by PALY/PAUSE/FF/FR/PRVE/NEXT/STOP.
- 4. You can press "STOP" key to stop record function after confirm.



Subscribe Record


1. In the DTV source,you can enter the Timer menu set the Subscribe Record $_{\circ}$ Press the "ENTER" key to add the record task $_{\circ}$

The Way: Main menu--->APPLICTIONS--->Programme Timers---> Programme Timers





2. If you enter the Timer Edit menu, you can set the record task that you want to record.



- 3. When you success to set the record task, if the TV is standby mode, it will auto power on when three minutes before the start of the task.
- 4. When the record task time is start, It will auto record, but you must check you USB storage device inserted and it is enough speed to record. Otherwise the task will failure.
- 5. The TV enter false standby mode when the task is start, you can press the "POWER" key to watch the TV program. You can do same operation as Direct Record. When you press "POWER" again, if the task is not over, the TV will power off the panel and continue to record. The TV will real power off until the record task is over.




