- 6. Do not use this apparatus near water, the apparatus shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and that no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the apparatus.
- 7. Clean only with dry cloth.
- 8. Do not install this apparatus in windtight places such as the wall-unit. Do not block any ventilation openings.
- 9. Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.

Motionless picture might cause permanent destruction to the display.


- Be sure not to display motionless picture on the LED TV for more than 2 hours, because it would cause picture remnants to appear, which is called "screen burns". To avoid such picture remnants, please decrease the "contrast" and "brightness" of the display when displaying motionless picture.
- While watching TV program in 4:3 size mode for a long time, there would be traces on the edge of the screen's left, right and center parts because of different transmition of the light on the screen. Similar impact on the screen will occur when playing DVD or connecting games control. Products destroyed by these reasons can't be guaranteed for maintenance.
- It might cause picture remnants to display electronic games and motionless picture of PC more than a period of time. To avoid such effect, please decrease the "contrast" and "brightness" when displaying motionless picture.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION


If a television is not positioned in a sufficiently stable location, it can be potentially hazardous due to falling. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:

- Using cabinets or stands recommended by the manufacturer of the television.
- Only using furniture that can safely support the television.
- Ensuring the television is not overhanging the edge of the supporting furniture.
- Not placing the television on tall furniture (for example, cupboards or bookcases) without anchoring both the furniture and the television to a suitable support.
- Not standing the televisions on cloth or other materials placed between the television and supporting furniture.

- The each USB terminal should be loaded with 0.5 A under normal operation;






• To avoid the TV overturning, when installed, it must with screw through screw hole on the base for fixing TV on the desk





• When you turning the TV set, do not hold the top side of the TV set, you should hold the bottom side.





• When you lifting the TV set, do not use one hand to handle it, you should lift the TV set by two hands.





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

1.2 Installation of Stand

The Wall Mount Kit can help install the TV on the wall.



1.6 Installation of Batteries



- 1. Open the back lid of the remote control.
- 2. Install two 7#(AAA)1.5V batteries. Ensure the correct polarity of the batteries.
- 3. Cover the back lid. Please take out of the batteries from the remote control for long time of no use.



If the remote control doesn't work properly,

please carry out the following checks. - Check the TV is turned on.

- Check the polarity of the batteries are correct.
- Check the batteries are not drained.
- Check the power supply is normal or the power cord is correctly connected.
- Check there are no special fluorescent light or neon light around.

2. Basic Operation

2.1 Power ON/OFF

- Connect the power cord to the **AC input**. Insert the power cord into the appropriate socket.
- Press the **Power switch** to switch on the TV, then press **Power** button to turn on the unit.
- Press the **Power switch** again to switch off the TV.

Note: After switch off the TV, please don't immediately re-open the power switch ,should be delayed one minute more to re-open the power switch.


2.2 Setting of Standby Mode

- Press (^し) button to turn on the unit.
- -Press (\circlearrowleft) button again to return the display to standby mode. The power indicator turns red.
- Be sure not to set your TV in standby mode for a long period of time.

2.3 Selection of Input Mode

This set has different signal source modes, you may continue to press the **SOURCE** button to select a signal source.

When selecting the signal source, the screen will display the information.



When there is no signal from the selected source, the warning message will be displayed as per illustration. Either change the channel in TV mode or press **SOURCE** button to change source.

2.4 Menu Option Adjustment

After you have installed the batteries into the remote control, you will need to set some preferences on the LED TV, using the menu system.

- The buttons for menu option adjustment include: **Menu,** ▲ , ▼ , ◀ , ▶ **Enter** buttons.
- Press the **Menu** button to open the OSD Menu, then press ▲, ▼ button to select the pages. The pages are displayed in the following sequence (circular display):

Note: " CHANNEL " is only for TV .

- 1 Press the **Menu** button to display the menu system.
- Press ▲, ▼ button to select the menu pages.
- 3 Press ◀, ▶ and then press ▲, ▼ button to select an item.
- Press ◀ , ► button to select or adjust a setting.
- If you do not make a selection within 15 seconds, the menu will close automatically.
- 6 Press the **Menu** button to return or exit OSD menu.

2.5 Auto Installation

If this is the first time you are turning on the TV and there are no programs in the TV memory, the "Auto Installation" menu will appear on the screen. There are 5 setups as follow:



2.6 Menu Functions

2.6.1 PICTURE Menu

This chapter will describe the function of Picture in mainmenu.

1.1Picture Menu

It will open the mainmenu by pressing down the button "MENU" on the remote. The focus will move to the sub items in the Picture menu by pressing down the button "RIGHT" and then functions in the Picture can be set. The Picture menu is shown as follows:





The result of the action pressing down some button when in Picture menu:

Key Stroke	Action
KEY_UP	Highlight the previous sub item. If it is the first button currently, then highlight the last one in the list.

2.6.2 Sound Menu

2.1Sound Menu

It will open the mainmenu by pressing down the button "MENU" and then press the button "down" on the remote. The focus will move to the sub items in the Sound menu by pressing down the button "RIGHT" and then functions in the Sound can be set. The Sound menu is shown as follows:





3.1Channel User Interface

Press "Menu" \rightarrow "Down (\blacktriangledown)" \rightarrow "Down (\blacktriangledown)" \rightarrow "Right (\blacktriangleright)" to enter channel operation user interface in ATV/DTV/Radio Source as follows:



There are following functions in this page:

Channel Management: To manage (Delete//Swap/Lock/Skip) all channels;

Favorite Management: To manage (Add/Delete) Favorite channels;

Country: To select country.

TV connection: To select the DTV signal mode(Air/Cable/Satellite)

Auto Search: To select auto search mode (DTV/ATV)

DTV Manual Search: To search digital channel by entering parameters manually(only for DTV)

ATV Manual Search: To search analogue channel b y entering parameters manually(only for ATV);

3.2 Function Description

3.2.1Channel Manager

Press "ENTER" or "RIGHT" key on "Channel management" of "Channel" page in ATV or DTV source. The operation interface shows as follow:



3.2.1.1Delet/Skip/Lock Channel

1) Press "UP (▲)" and "DOWN (▼)" key to select the programs to be deleted and press "RED", "GREEN" or "YELLOW" key to mark them as following:



2) After marking press "MENU" key to save the result.

3.2.1.2Swap Channel

Select the program to be swapped and press "BLUE" key, the selected program will wink and them select another program and press "BLUE" key to swap them.

3.2.2Favorite Management

1) Press "ENTER" or "RIGHT" key on "Favorite management" of "Channel" page in ATV or DTV source. The operation interface shows as follow:



2) Press "UP (▲)" and "DOWN (▼)" key to select the programs to be added into favorite list and press "RED", "GREEN", "YELLOW" or "BLUE" key to mark them as following:



3) Press "MENU"key to return "Favorite management" page and save the result.

3.2.3Country



1) Select the country.

3.2.4Auto Search

3.2.4.1 Air signal mode

Select "Auto Search" item to enter auto search user operation interface as following:



All Mode: Select "All" item to scan all digital channels carried by current signal mode firstly and then switch to scan all analog channels in selected country automatically. User can skip digital search to analog search directly by entering "EXIT" or "MENU" key and can also stop auto scan directly by entering "EXIT" or "MENU" during analog scanning.

Digital Mode: Select "Digital" item to search all digital channels in selected country carried by current signal mode. User can stop search directly by entering "EXIT" or "MENU" key.

Analog Mode: Select "Analogue" item to search all analogue channels in selected country carried by current signal mode. User can stop search directly by entering "EXIT" or "MENU" key.

All search mode processing interface display as following:



3.2.5Digital Manual Search

3.2.5.1 Air signal mode

Select "Digital Manual Search" item to enter air channel manual search in DTV source and the user operation interface as following:



Select channel number by "RIGHT" key or entering number directly. The strength and the quality shows at the bottom. Press "ENTER" key on "Start" item to start current channel search. The manual searching UI and the auto searching UI are the same.

3.2.6Analog Manual Search

Select "Analogue Manual Search" item to enter analogue manual search in ATV source and the user operation interface as following:



These parameters in this page show as the following table:

Enter these parameters and then select "Search" item to enter analog channel tune. A dialog popup on left bottom:



Press "Left (◀)" to search channel carried in lower frequency and "Right (▶)" key to search channel carried in higher frequency. Press "MENU" key to return to "Channel-Analogue Manual Search" page and press "RED" key to save the scanned channel to database.

User also can select "Fine Tune" item to fine tune current channel and the UI shows as the last picture. Press "Left (\blacktriangleleft) ", "Right (\blacktriangleright) " key to fine tune current channel. Press "MENU" key to return to "Channel-Analogue Manual Search" page and press "RED" key to save the tuned channel to database.





2.7 Using the Teletext Function (Optional)

Note: When pressing the Teletext function keys on the remote control, if the word "NO TTX" is displayed onscreen, it means the related function can't be used.

Teletext is a free service broadcast by most TV stations which give up-to-theminute information news, weather, television programs, share price, subtitles, and many other topics.

To operate TELETEXT

- ※ Select a TV station on which Teletext is being transmitted.
- Press the TXT button once to bring up the teletext screen. Two page numbers are displayed on the screen headline. The first page number indicates your selection, while the second shows the current page displayed.

Teletext Page Selection

- Enter the required Teletext page as a three digit numbers. The selected page number is displayed at the top left corner of the screen. The Teletext page counter searches until the selected page number is located, so that the desired page is displayed on the screen.
- ※ The ▲ , ▼ buttons can be used to select the preceding or following page.
- ※ Fast find using the 4 coloured buttons. Four subject-headed pages can be selected quickly by pressing the corresponding coloured buttons Red, Green, Yellow, or Blue on the remote control.

Useful features for Teletext

Index

Press this button to select the index page that displays the list of teletext contents.

Hold

- * The teletext page you have selected may contain more information than is on the screen; The rest of the information will be displayed after a period of time on a sub page.
- Press Hold button to stop the automatic page change. The hold symbol will be displayed at the top left-hand corner on the screen and the automatic page change will be stopped.
- Press Hold button again to continue.

Reveal

- Press this button once to display concealed information, such as solutions of riddles, puzzles or a quiz.
- ※ Press this button again to conceal the revealed answers.

Mix

Size

Press repeatedly to double the character size in the following order: Upper half of the page, Lower half of the page, Return to normal size.

SUBPAGE

※ Press this button to enter the sub page mode. You can use ▲, ▼ button to display sub page; Press again to exit.

CANCEL

* Press to hide teletext contents, press again to reappear.
