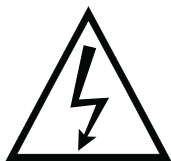

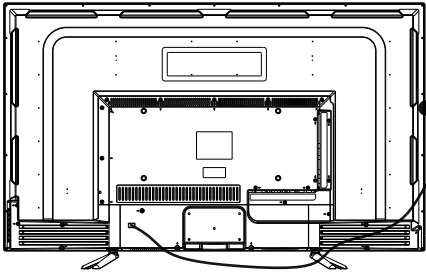

The TV is packaged with the TV stand separated from the cabinet. To setup the TV table stand, please carry out the installation according to the instructions below.

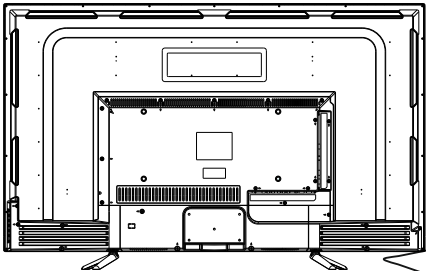


Step One

Place the TV faced down on a soft cloth or cushion to prevent the panel from being damaged

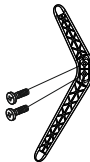
- The panel can be scratched easily, so please:

 2. Use soft cloth or cushion to face the TV panel, Do not put TV on the table directly.

Always unplug the AC cord first when installing/removing the stand.



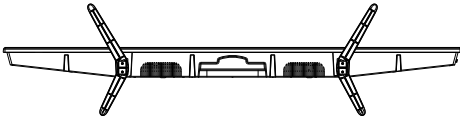
Step Two

Take the base. Please align the screw holes of the base and the TV, and then insert the 4 screws into the 4 holes on the base and tighten them.



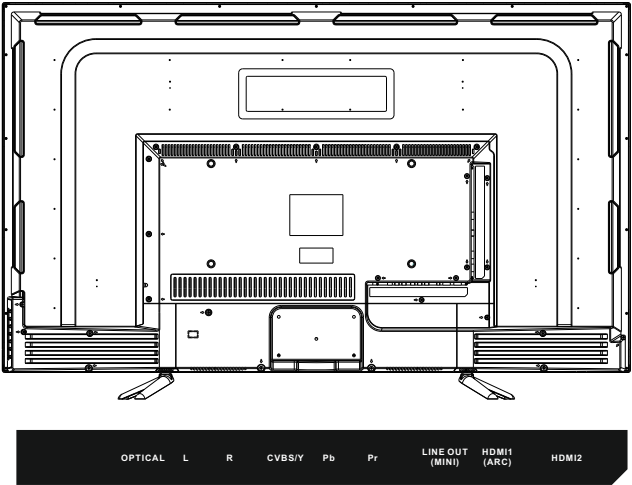

Side Keypad and Front Panel

Keypad Buttons

If you cannot locate your remote, you can use the side keypad buttons on your TV to operate many TV features.



INPUT: Displays the Source Select List.

MENU: Displays the TV Main Menu.

CH▲: Scans up through the channel list. In the TV menu system, it acts like the up arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.

CH▼: Scans down through the channel list. In the TV menu system, it acts like the down arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.

VOL+: Increases the volume. In the TV menu system, it acts like the right arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.

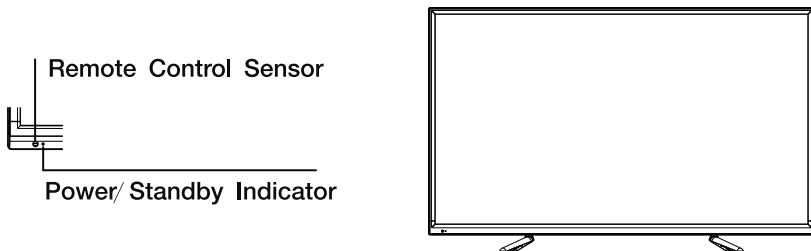
VOL-: Decreases the volume. In the TV menu system, it acts like the left arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.

POWER (⏻): Turns the TV on and off.

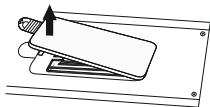
Power/Standby Indicator: Blue and red dual-color LED. It shows red when the TV is turned off and blue when turned on. **Remote Control Sensor:** Remote control IR sensor, which receives infrared ray sent by remote control.



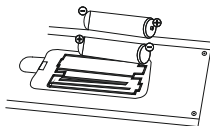
Remote Control Instructions

Inserting Batteries in the Remote

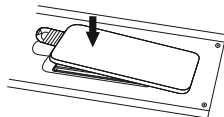
1. Remove the battery compartment cover from the back of the remote control by lifting the cover.



2. Insert 2AAA batteries, making sure the polarities(+and-) are aligned correctly.



3. Replace the cover.



If the remote control does not work, check these points:

- Are the polarities (+, -) correct?
- Are the batteries worn out?
- Is there an AC power failure?
- Is the power cord plugged in?
- Is there any interference or block near the remote control sensor?

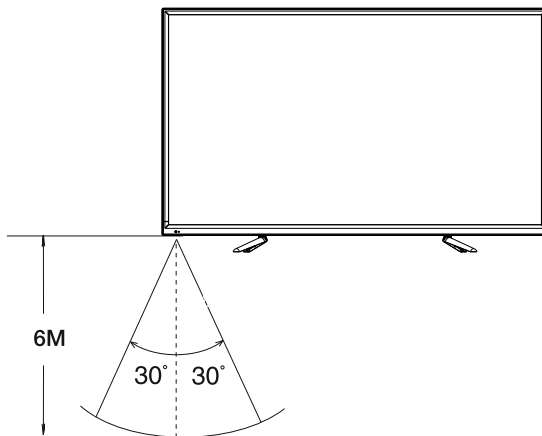

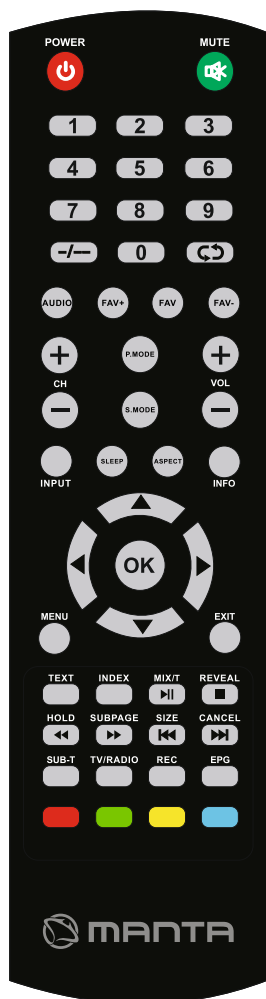

Learning about Remote Control



POWER: Press the TV on and standby.

-/-- : Call up the program table.

↶↷ : go back to the last viewed channel .

AUDIO: Switch the audio channel in DVD or multimedia mode.

FAV: Press to display the favorite channel list which you stored before.

FAV+ or FAV-: Scans up or down through the current favorite channel list.

CHANNEL “+” “-”: Press to change the TV channels.

VOL “+” “-”: Press to increase or decrease the volume.

P.MODE: Press to select the picture mode.

S.MODE: Press to select the sound mode.

SLEEP: Press to select a preset time interval for automatic shut off.

ASPECT: Aspect Ratio .

INPUT: Accesses the available input channels, Use the arrows to highlight options, and press OK to select.

INFO : Displays the current input information.

◀▶▲▼ : Use to select on-screen menu items and change menu values.

OK: Enter and conform button.

MENU: Press to display the OSD menu.

EXIT: Exit the menu

TEXT: To enter Teletext mode

INDEX: To display the index page

MIX: TV and TXT picture are mixed together in transparent background.

REVEAL: Teletext mode-To reveal or hide the hidden words.

HOLD: Teletext mode-Hold current page which is displayed.

SUBPAGE: Sub coded page access.

SIZE: Change the size of display in Teletext mode.

CANCEL: To cancel the display.

Basic Operations

Turning On and Off

Connect the AC cord to power the TV. At this time the TV will enter standby mode and power indicator will turn red.

Use Power button (⏻) on the side panel of TV or on the remote control to turn on the TV. After switching off the TV for 5 seconds, you can turn on TV again.

Select Input Source

Press **INPUT** button to display the input source list. Press ▼ / ▲ or **OK** button to select the input source you want, Press **OK** button to enter the input source, Press **EXIT** button to quit. (Options:DTV,ATV,AV, Component,HDMI1,HDMI2,HDMI3, Smart TV , Media)



Basic Operations

First Time Settings

Connect an RF cable from the TV's input called "ANT IN" and to your TV Aerial socket.

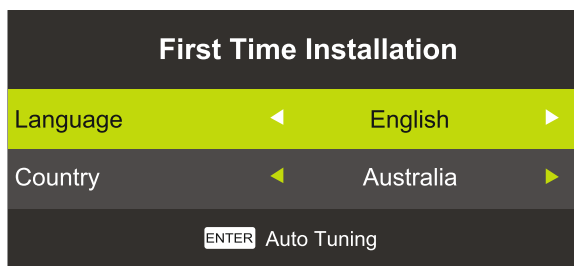

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select **Signal Information**, press the **OK** button to see the detail information about the signal. Only available when there is signal in DTV.

Electronic Program Guide(EPG)

EPG TV guide (for DTV mode only)

EPG stands for Electronic Program Guide. It is supplied by the program providers and offers information about the programs to be broadcast. You can access it in digital mode by pressing the EPG button on the remote control.

- Before you can view any EPG information, you have to activate every channel for which you want to view program information. To do this, use the ▲/▼ buttons to select a channel in the left column, then press OK to confirm.
- Press the ◀/▶ buttons to switch between columns.
- Press the ▲/▼ buttons to select a different channel/program in the list.
- Press the RECORD ● button to schedule a recording for the selected program.
- Press the GREEN ■ button to schedule a reminder for the selected program.
- Press the YELLOW ■ button to display the TV guide of the previous day.
- Press the BLUE ■ button to display the TV guide of the next day.
- Press the INFO button to display details information.

Insert your USB memory device into USB slot first.

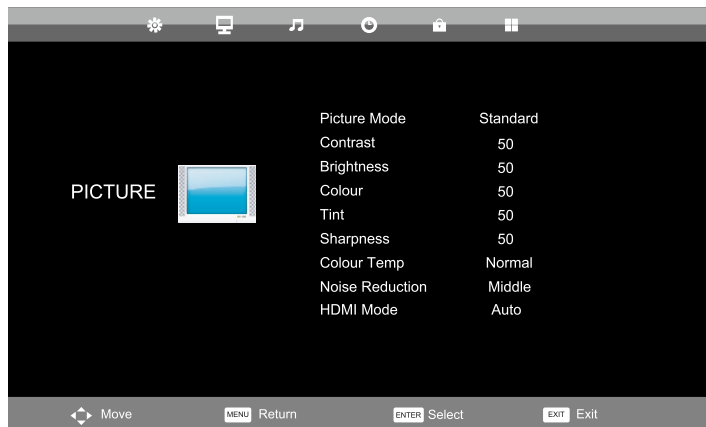

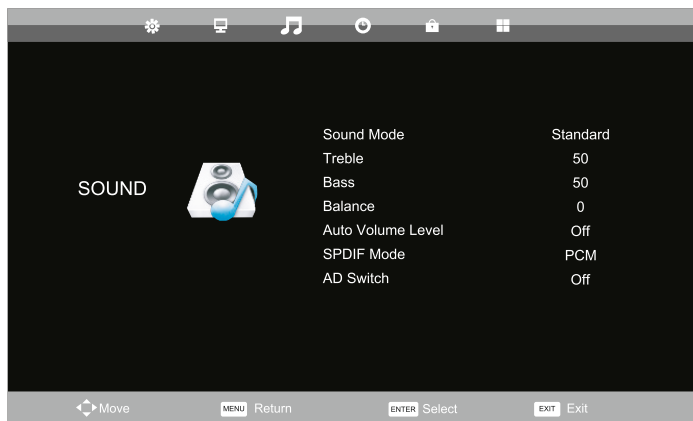

SPDIF Mode

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select SPDIF Mode, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select Off / PCM / Auto.

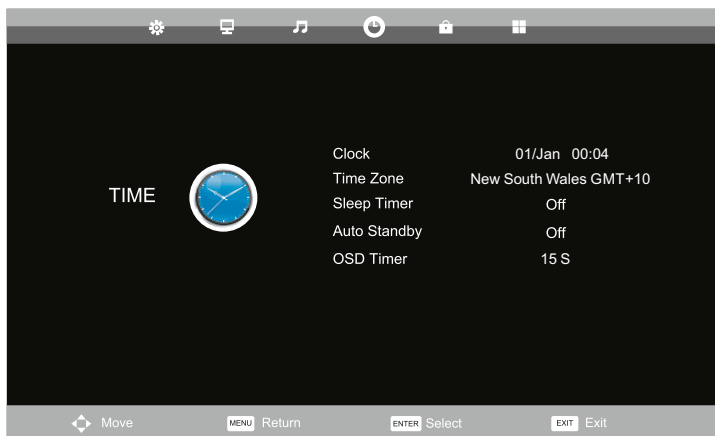

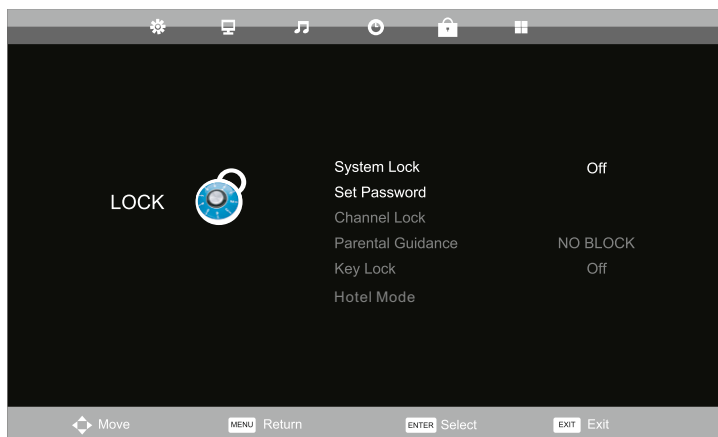

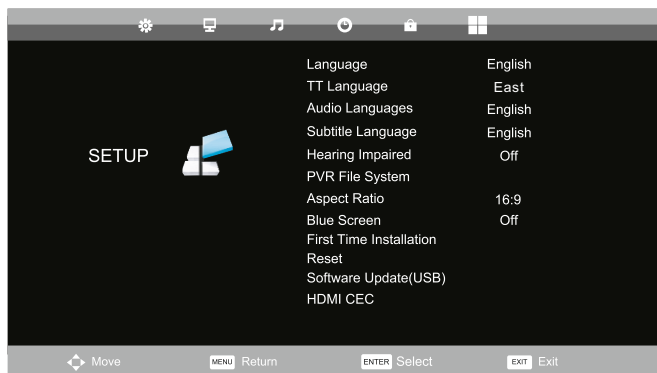

- 2.Select the DTV program and channel you wish to record.
- 3.Press [REC] button to enter PVR mode and start recording. PVR control bar on the screen shown below. You can select the appropriate settings required. You could change the mode of Recording menu by OK button.
- 4.If you wish to stop the recording, press [■] button and the recording will stop.
