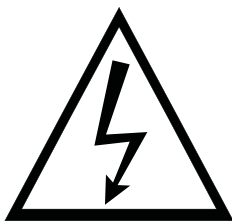

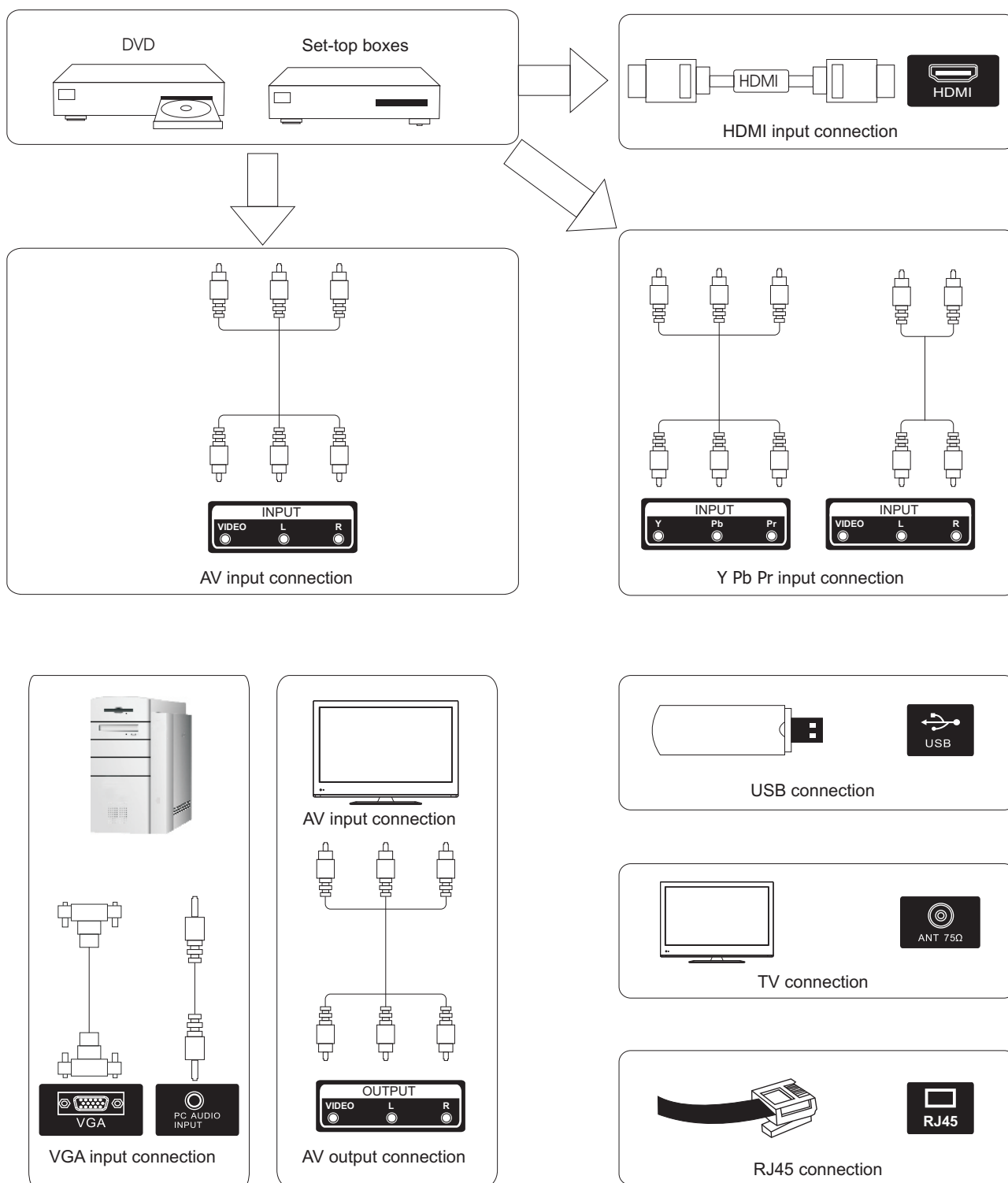

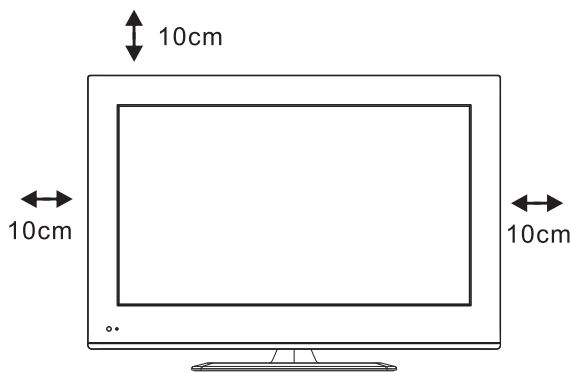

Install And Connect TV



Set your TV

To put your TV in a firm place which can bear the weight of the TV.

To avoid danger, please don't expose the TV near water or heating place (such as light, candle, heating machine), do not block the ventilation at the back of TV.

Connect antenna and power

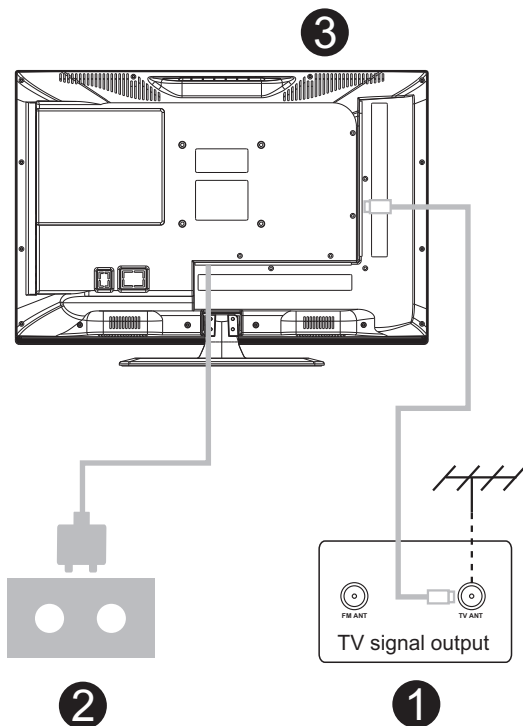
1. Connect the antenna cable to the antenna socket on the back of the TV.
2. To plug the power cord of TV (AC 100-240V~ 50/60Hz).

Turn on TV

3. Press the power button of the TV the indication light will turn to green. if it is on standby mode (the light is red), press the power button on the remote control to turn on the TV.

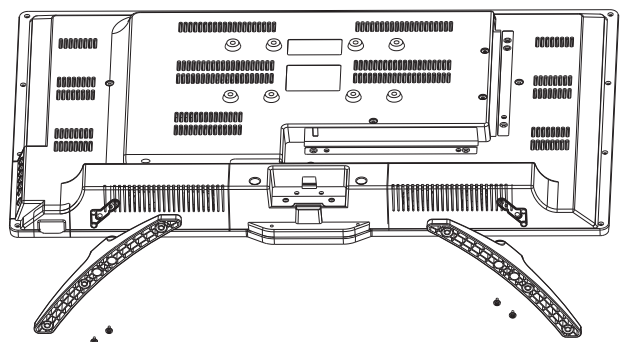

TV Stand Installation Instructions

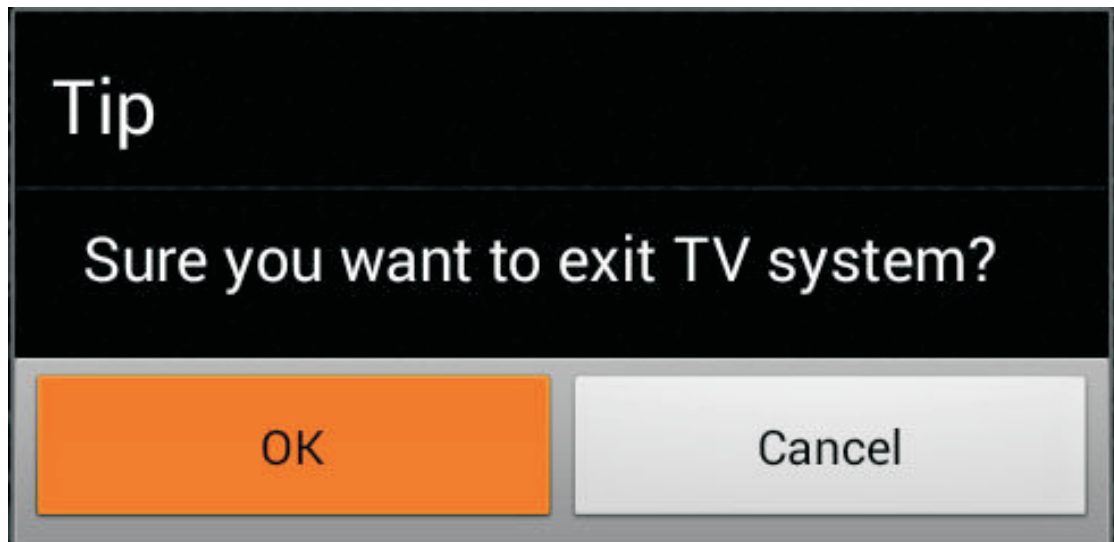
1. Open the carton and remove the TV and scattered accessories and base (some models without base).
2. To avoid the injury of the TV, covered with a soft mattress, put it on the table, face down on a soft mattress, the base of the neck is fixed on the TV with screws.
3. Screw the base and connected to the TV.
4. The installation is complete.



1.0 Enter the main menu

4 ways are allowed to enter the main menu interface:

1) In TV status, press the [Exit] key, a tip box appears on the screen (as the picture as below), now press the [ENTER] key, Then the screen get into the main menu.



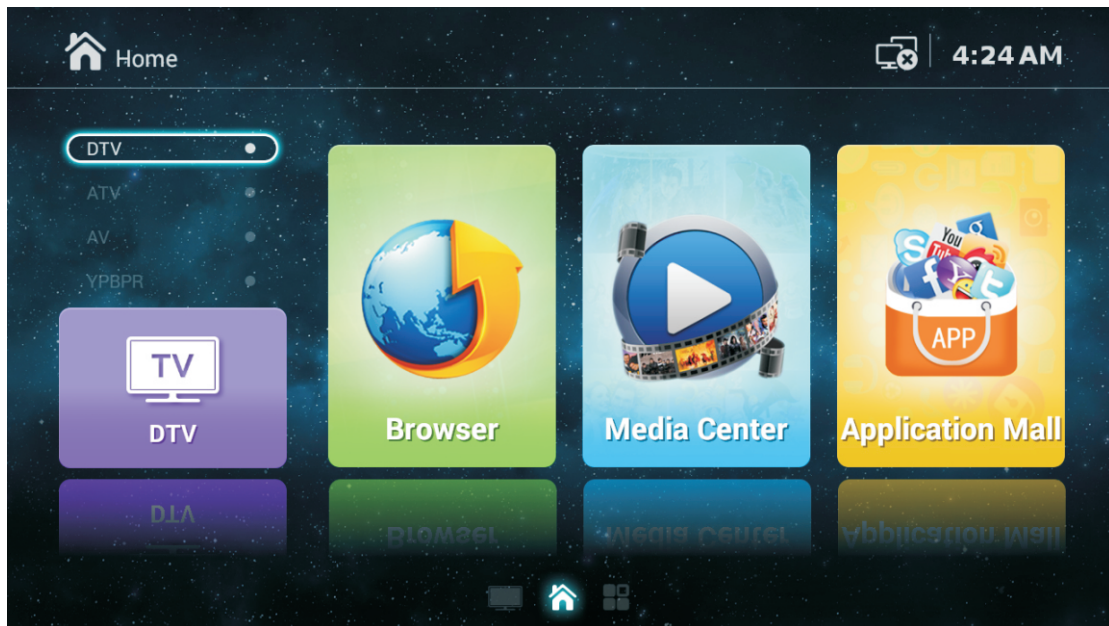
2) In TV channel, press the right key, then you can enter launcher.

3) Press the [Home] key.

4) Select the home from the 'Boot Loader' in setting interface, then you can enter the home next time.

1.1 The introduce of main menu

The default page (the second page of home) is shown below:



The main menu has three pages, you can press left and right key to select.

Each page is divided into three columns, in the top, they all show network status, time, weather. In the bottom, they show the current page.

The first page, no pictures can be seen, you can enter the TV channel directly when you switch to the page.

The second page, there are some entrance about Internet browser, Local media, App store.

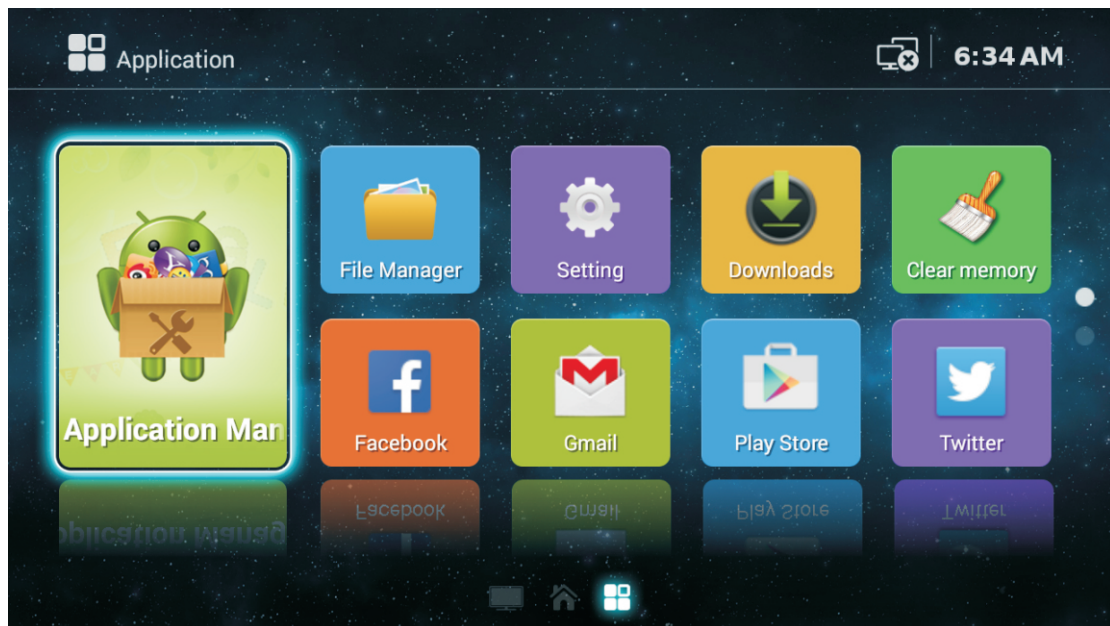
The third page, there are all applications

Press the up and down key, you can see applications in different pages.



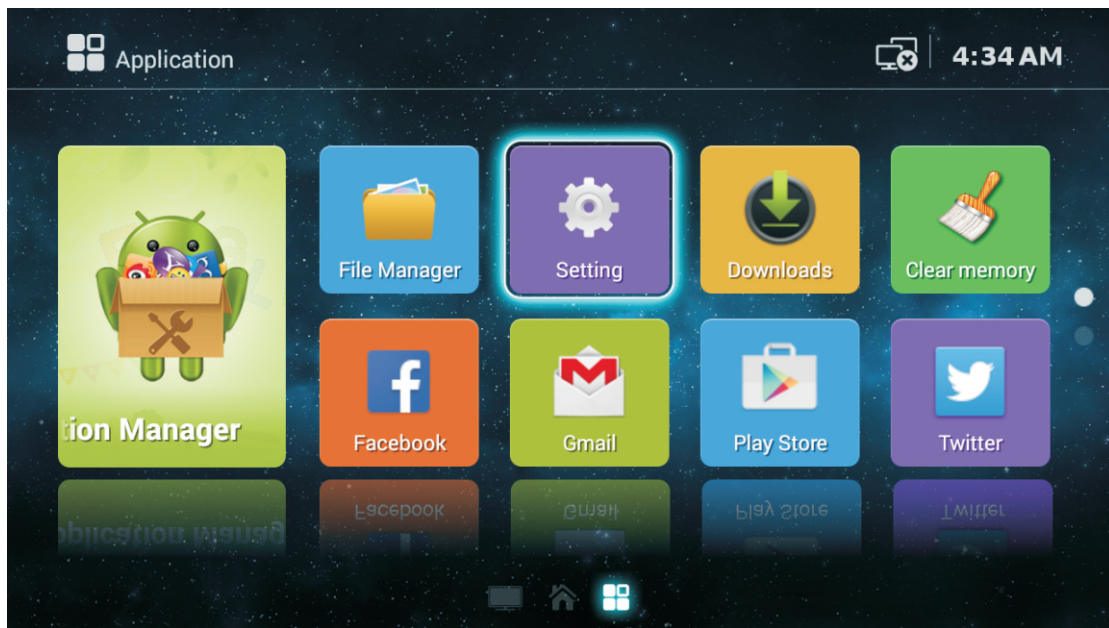
This menu has all installed application, you can press up, down, left, right key to select what you want and press [ENTER] to enter.

1.2 Exit

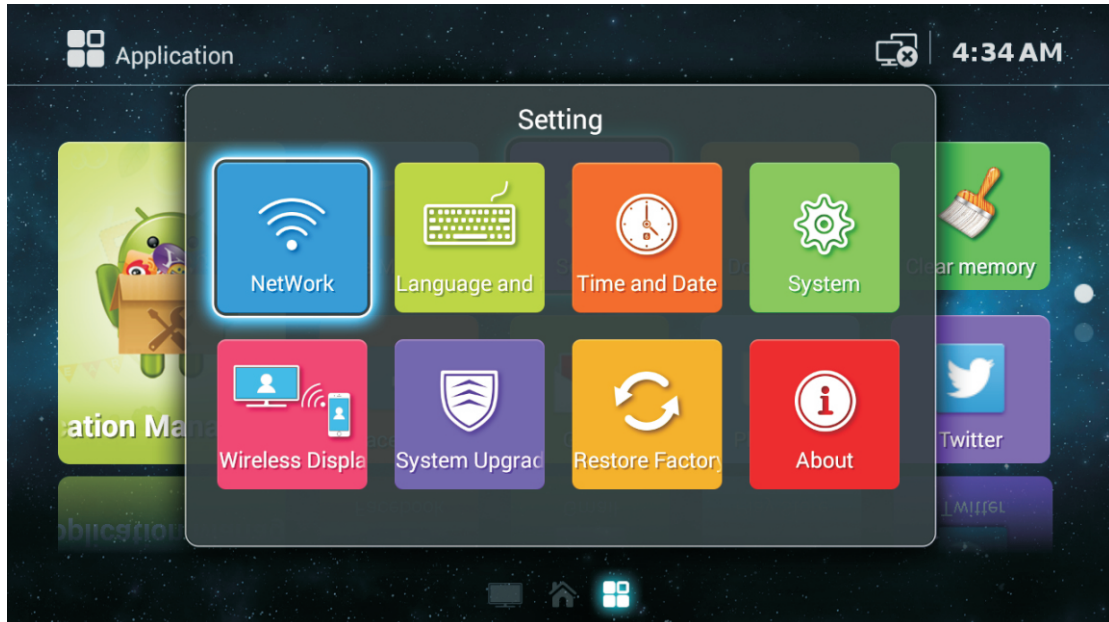
2 ways to exit the main menu

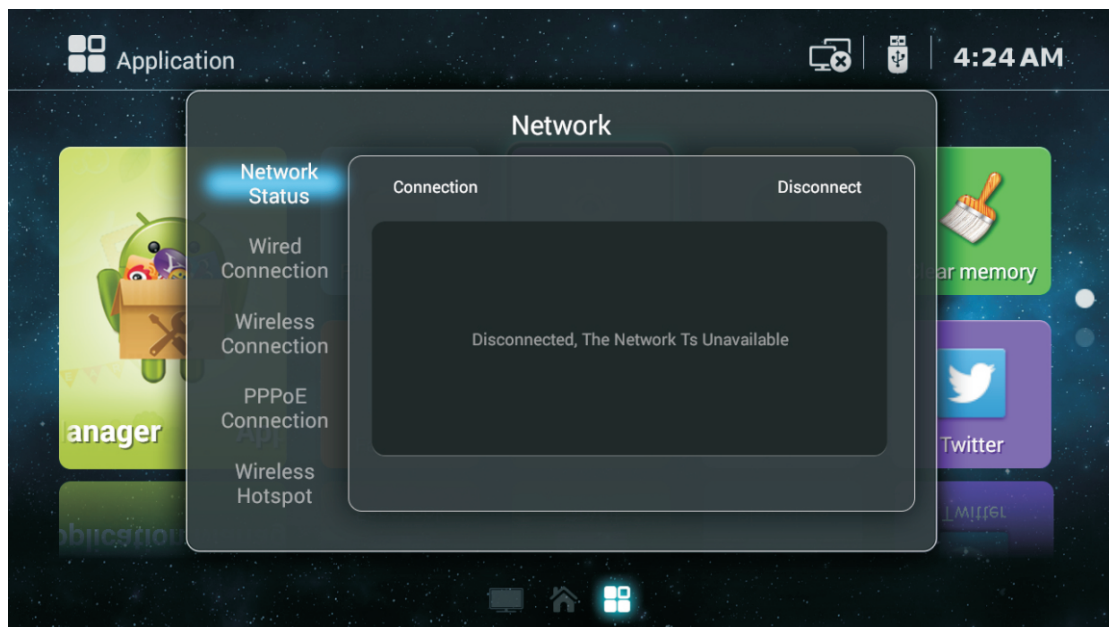
Select the 'setting' icon in the main page, then you can see as follows:

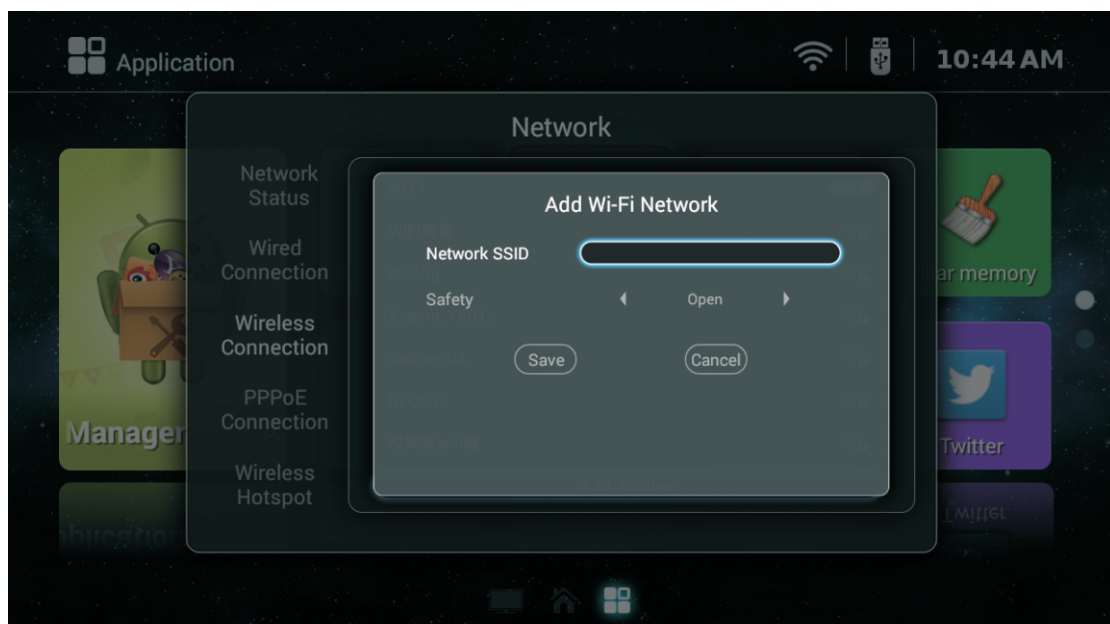
The current network status can be seen in this menu. Press up and down key to select the Enter option, press left and right key to switch the cursor position. Press [Exit] key to exit.



2.1.2 Wired connection



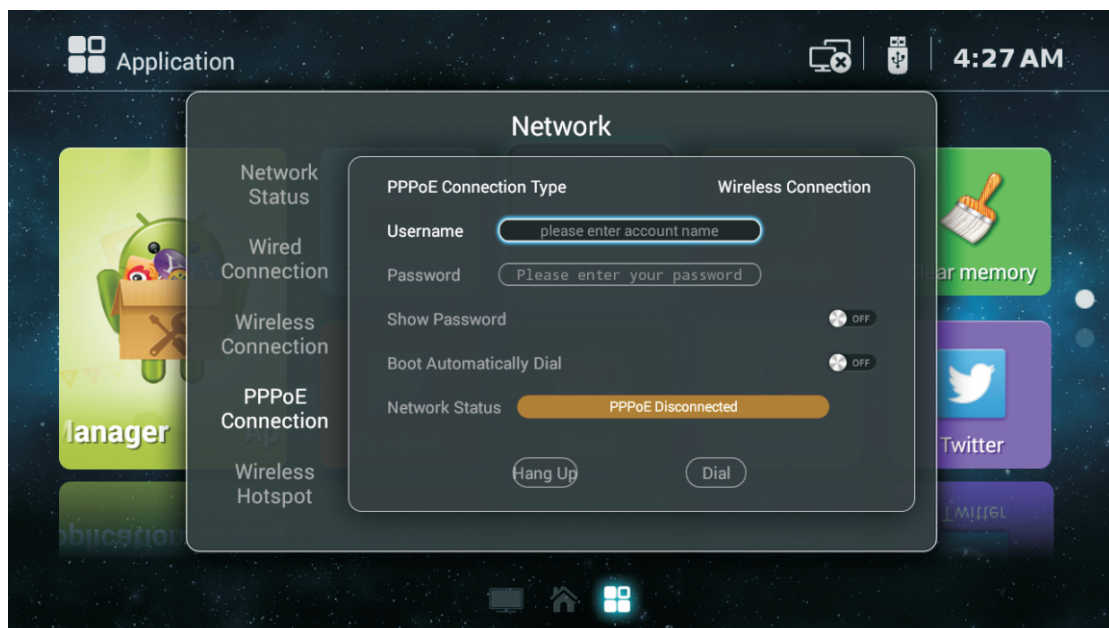
Press up and down key to select the left option, press left and right key to switch the cursor position. Press the [ENTER] key to switch  to . Press [Exit] key to exit.



2.1.3 Wireless Setup



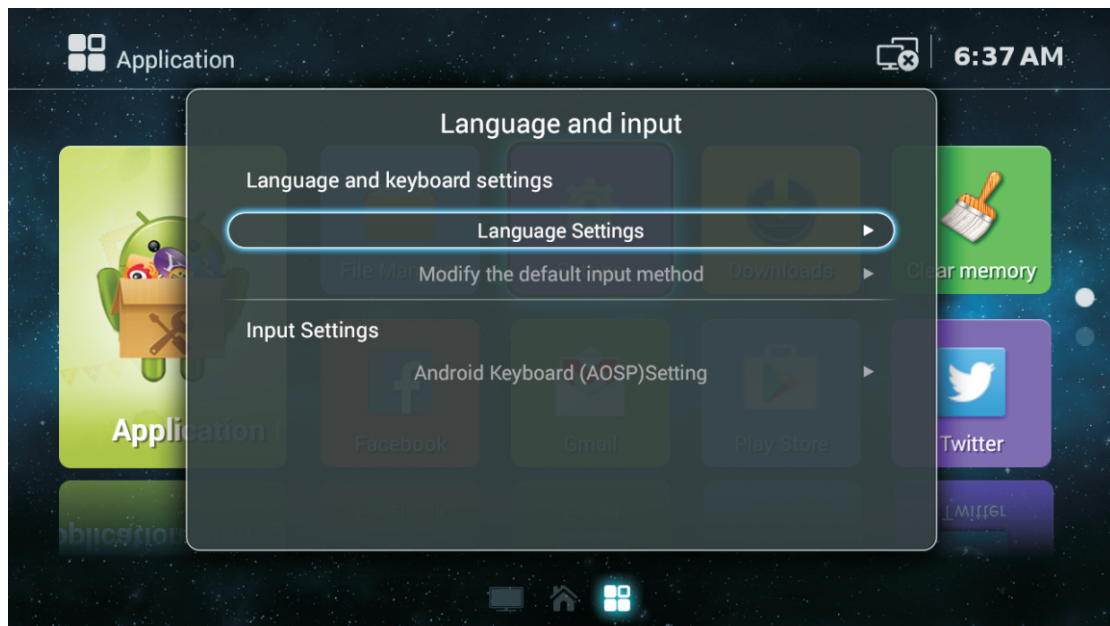
Press up and down key to select the left option, press left and right key to switch the cursor position. Press the [ENTER] key to switch  to . Press [Exit] key to exit.

2.1.4 PPPOE dial-up settings

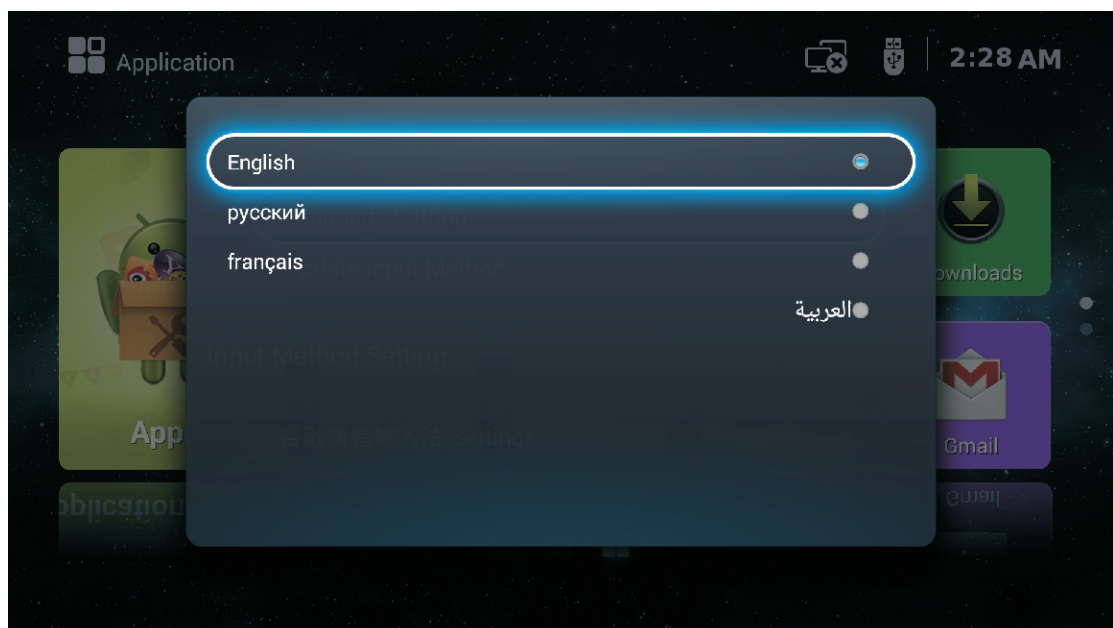


Press up and down key to select the, press left or right key to switch the cursor position. Press the [ENTER] key to switch  to . Press [Exit] key to exit.

2.2 Language and Keyboard Settings

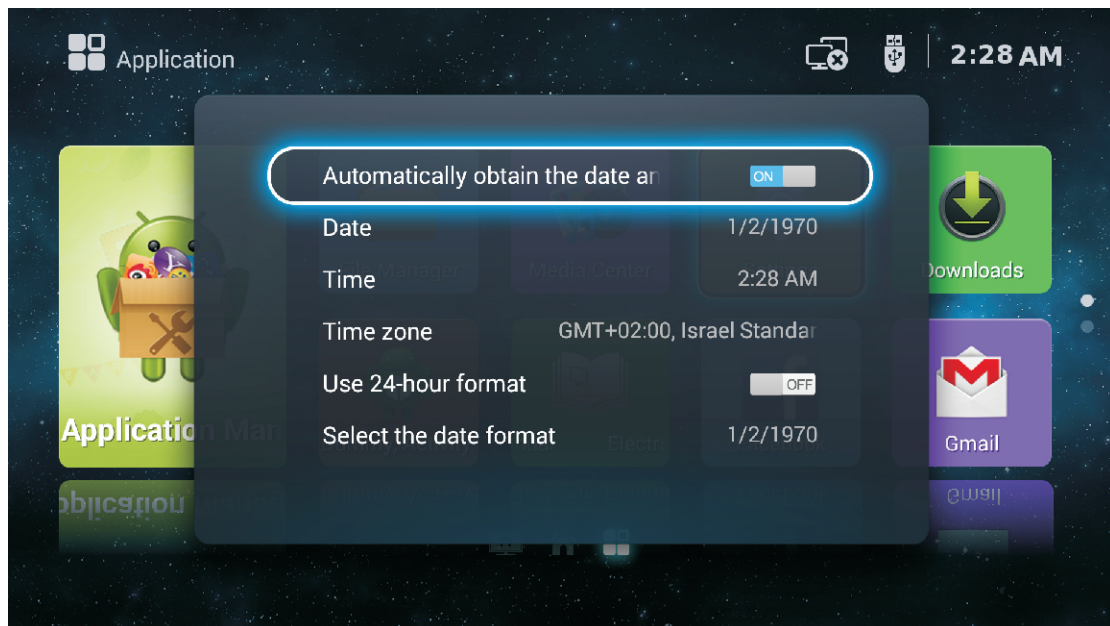




Press up and down key to select, press [ENTER] key to select. Press [Exit] key to previous menu. For example:



To set language, press up and down key to select language, press [ENTER] to set.

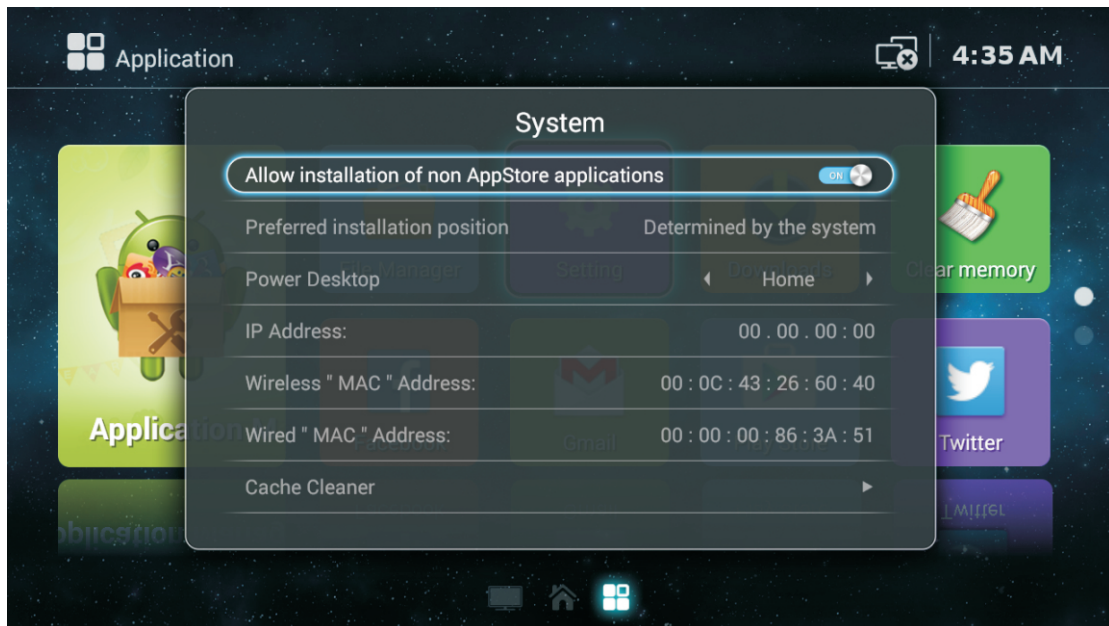
2.3 Time and Date settings



Press up and down key to switch selection, press the [ENTER] key to switch  to . Press [Exit] key to exit the previous menu.

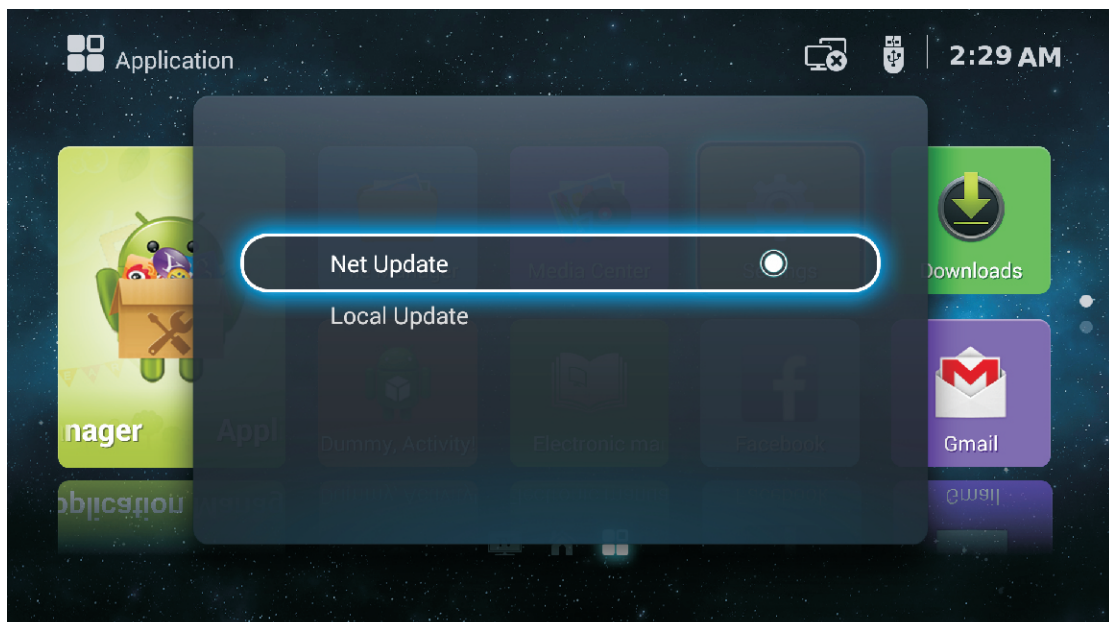
2.4 System

2.5 System backup upgrade

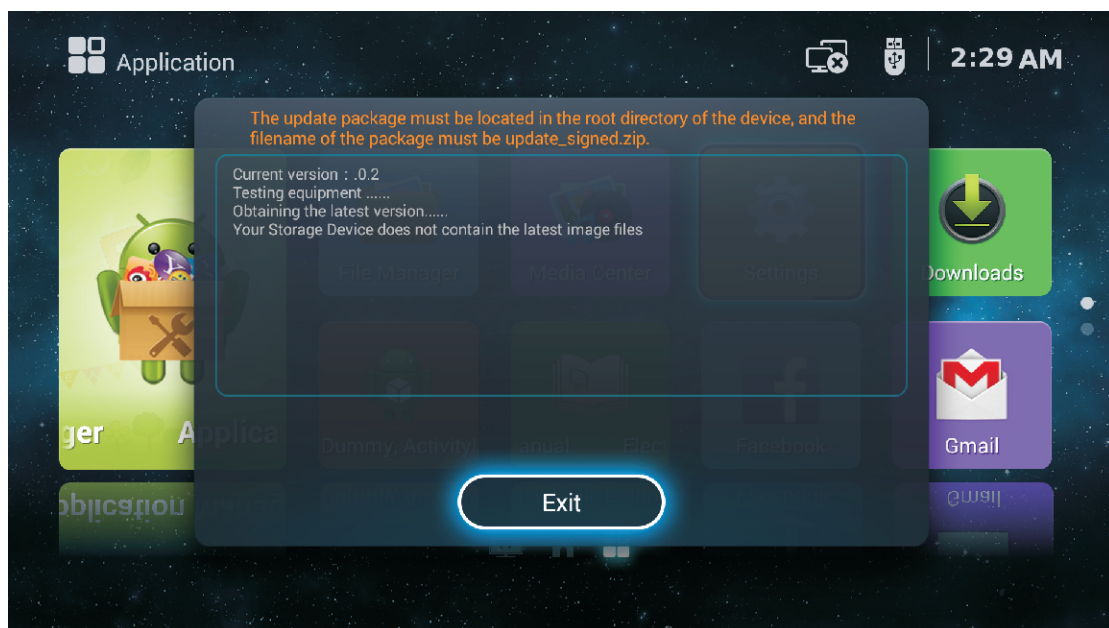
The interface has three options includes system upgrade, system information. Press up and down key to select, press [ENTER] key to enter. Press [Exit] key to exit.

network is normal and the server has new version then you can enter the next step and choose whether to load upgrade package, it will upgrade automatically when the load is completed.

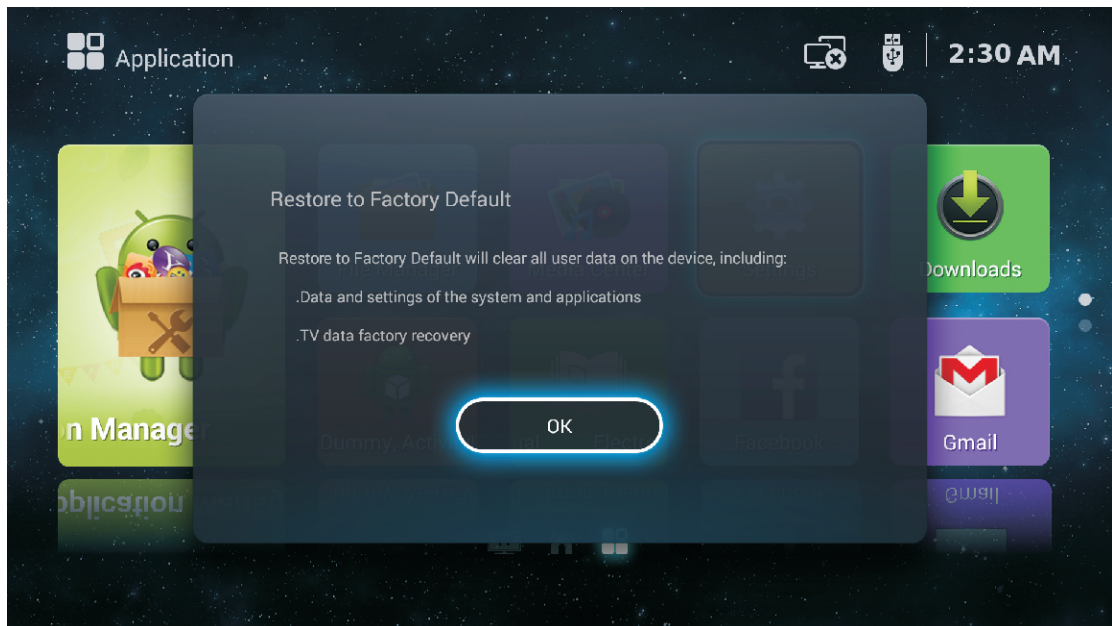
If the user insert with U disk with upgrade files, local upgrade interface is shown below:



Press [ENTER] key when the cursor is on “upgrade now” and the interface will come into upgrade status. You just need to wait the upgrade is completed.

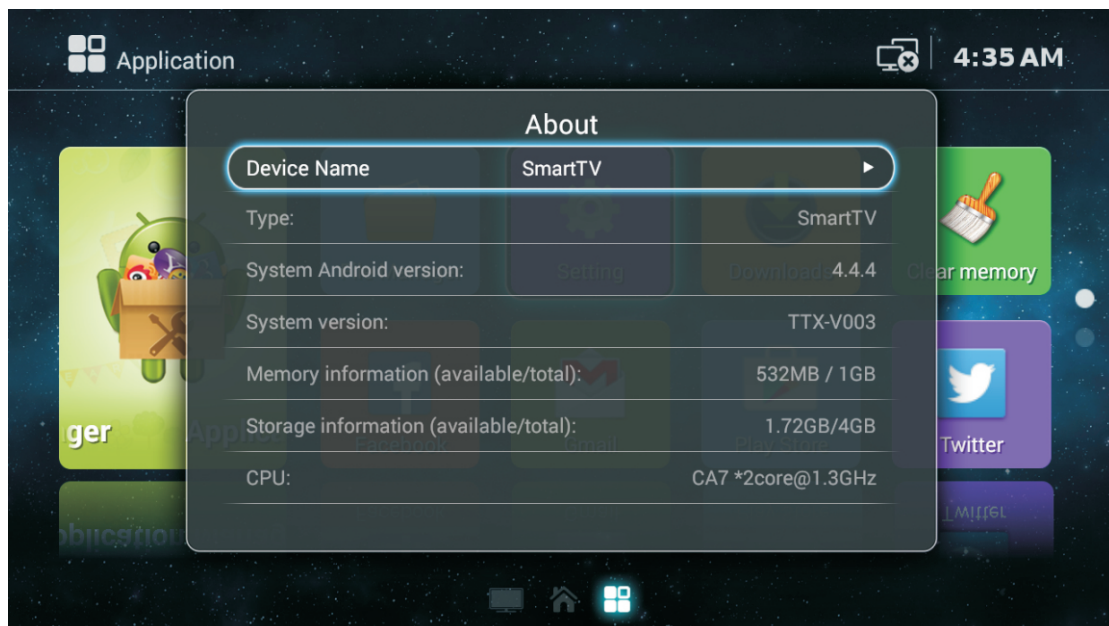
2.6 Restore to Factory Default

2.7 About



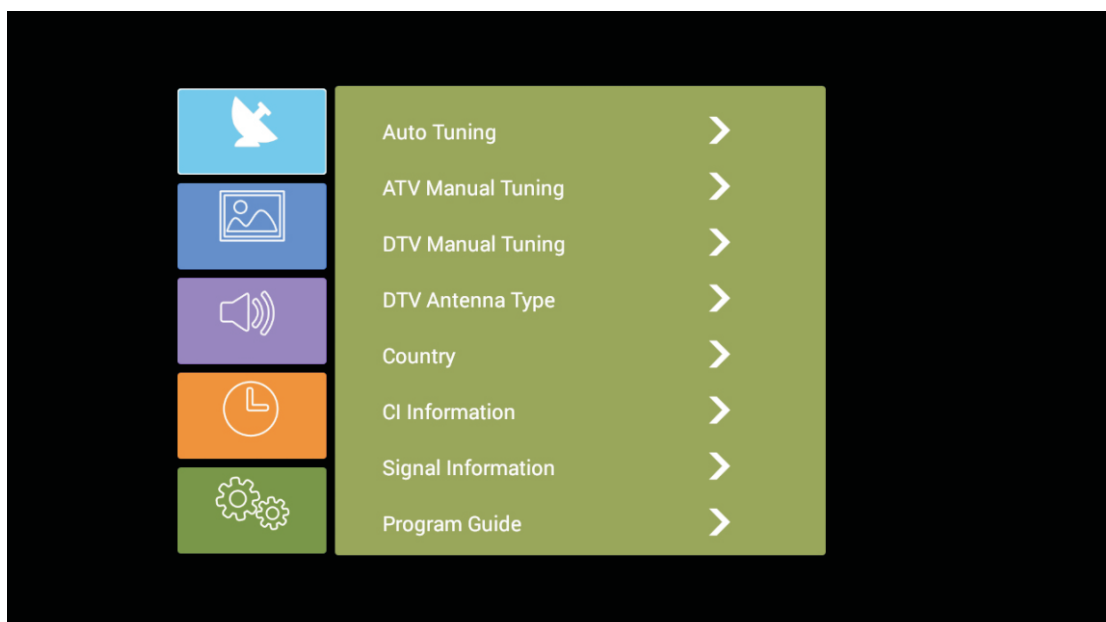
The menu shows system version information, memory information and so on .Press up and down key to select an option .Press [Exit] key to exit previous menu.

TV menu

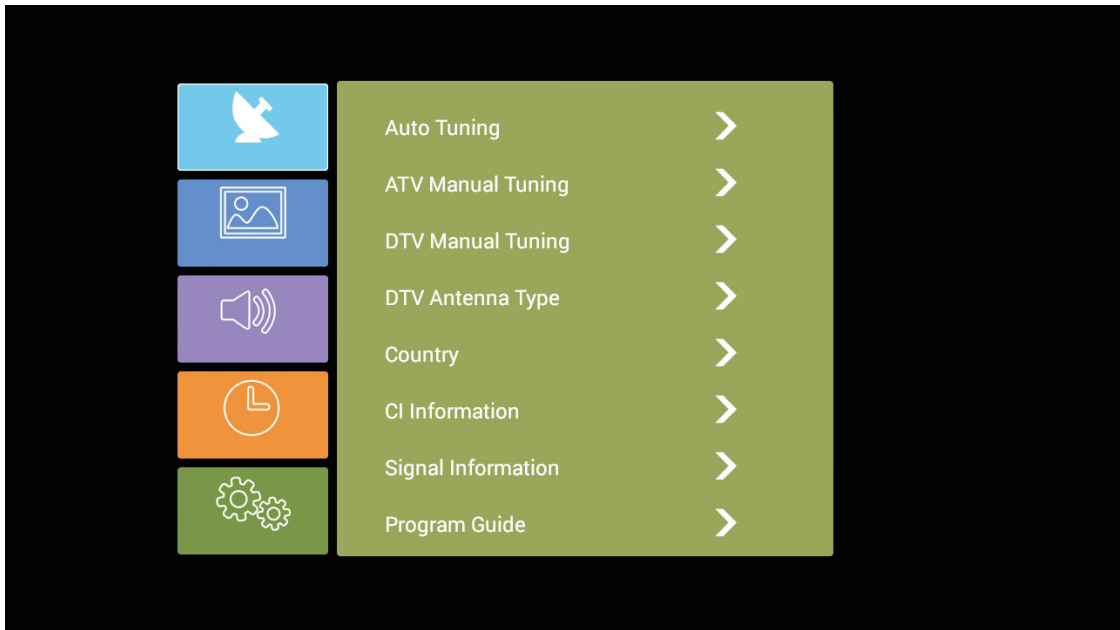
In various TV channels, the screen will pop up TV menu interface. The menu is a platform which provides with some related settings. It has five big options includes Channel set, Picture set, Sound set, Time set and Advanced menu.

3.1 Channel Settings

Only in analog TV channel and digital TV channel, the option can be chosen. The PAL . DTV interface is shown below:



The NTSC interface is shown below:



Press up and down key select different functions, if the focus moves to automatic station search, press [ENTER] key to search automatically.

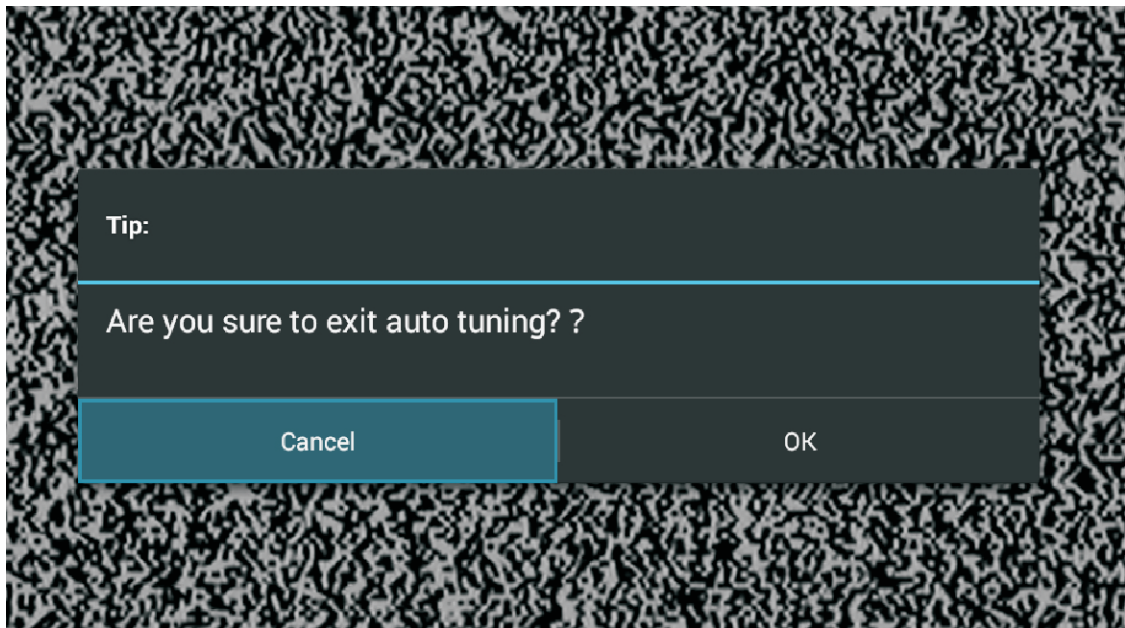
3.1.1 Automatic Search

The PAL Automatic Search interface is shown below:



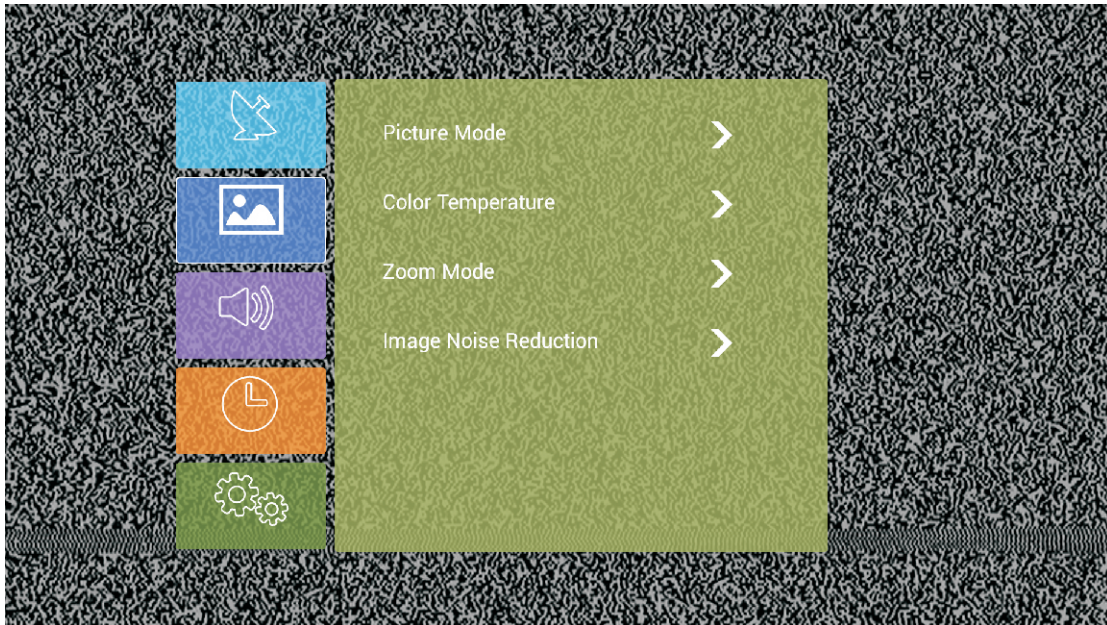
At the same time, press [Exit] key it will pop up tip box as fellow, you can choose whether to continue search.

The selection functions are about picture adjustment, press up and down key to move the focus, press [ENTER] key to choose and left and right key to adjust corresponding value, you can choose as follow:



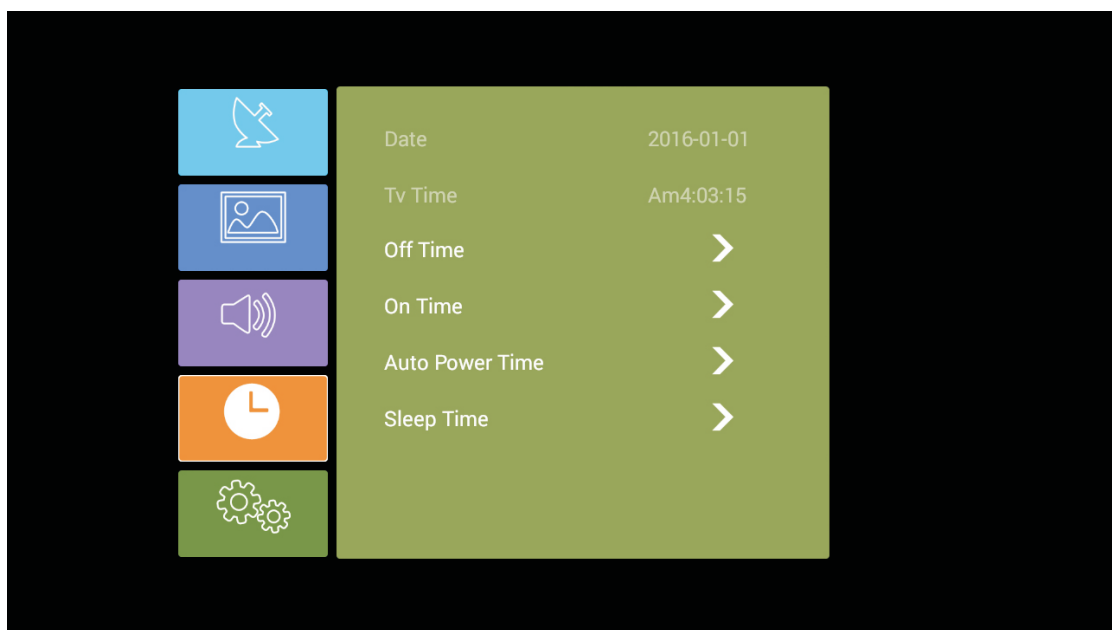
3.3 Sound Settings

Press up and down key to move the focus, press [ENTER] key to choose and left and right key to adjust corresponding value, you can choose as follow:



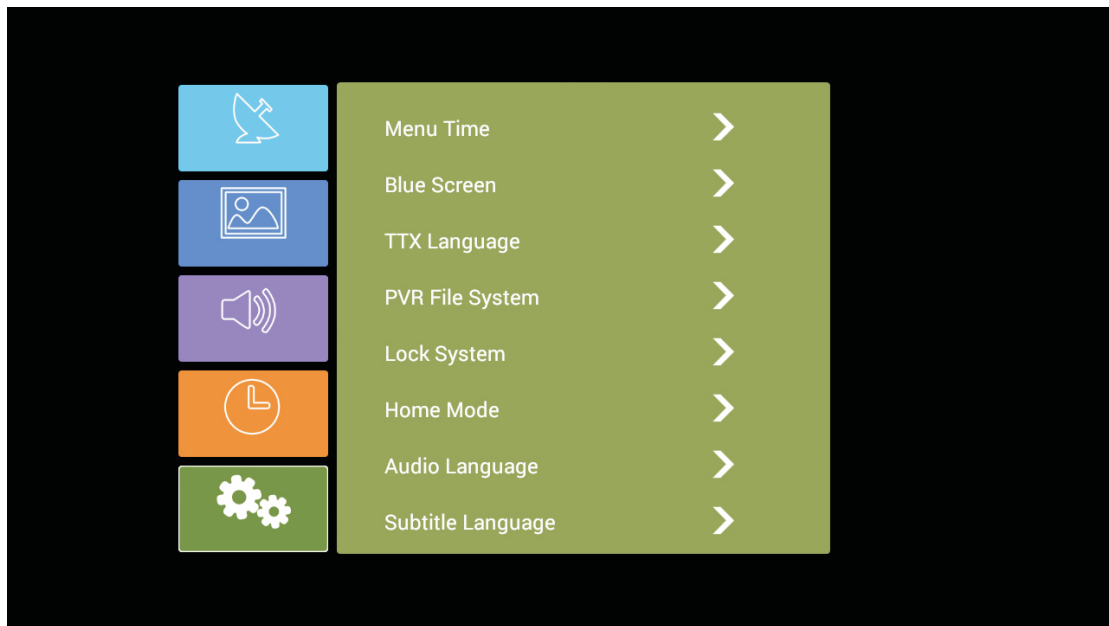
3.4 Time and Date Settings

3.5 Advanced Settings

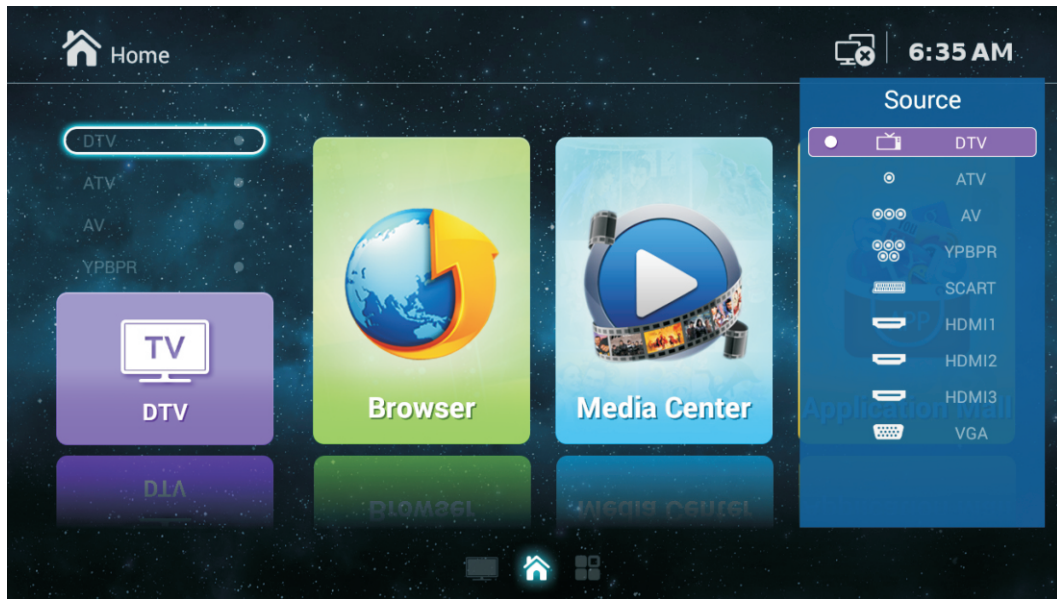
Press up and down key to move the focus, press [ENTER] key to sure and left and right key to adjust corresponding value. The interface is shown below:

You can adjust the image thru manual operation: consult instruction of vernier regulation, or adjust the direction of the external antenna. • If you use an indoor antenna, under certain circumstances signal reception may be more difficult. Adjust the direction of the antenna for optimum reception. If this does not improve reception, you may have to switch to an external antenna. |
| No picture | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check if the antenna at the back of the TV is connected properly. • View other channels to see if the problem still occurs. |
| Video appears with no audio | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Try increasing the volume. • Check if the TV's sound is on mute or not. |
| Audio is present, but video does not appear or is discolored | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Try adjusting the contrast and brightness. |

| Vertical line blinking (PC Mode) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enter the main menu, and adjust the vertical placement to eliminate the vertical line. |
| Horizontal tearing (PC Mode) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adjust the horizontal placement of the screen to clear any horizontal lines. |
| Screen is too bright or dark (PC Mode) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adjust the brightness or contrast in the main menu. |
| No response from the PC | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check if the PC's display resolution is set to a compatible resolution for the TV. |
| Lines appearing when a device is connected to the RCA port | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make sure you are using a cable of good quality. |
| Problems are unresolved | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unplug the power cable and wait for 30 seconds, then reconnect to the socket. If problems still persist, do not attempt to repair the TV by yourself. Kindly contact the service center. |

Do not leave your TV displaying a static image, whether it is from a paused video, menu screen, etc. for an extended period of time, doing so will damage the display and may cause image burn-in.

Remote Controller

- 1.POWER:** Turn on the TV or enter standby mode.
- 2.MUTE:** Turn off the sound and turn on when press again.
- 3.0-9:** Figures "0-9" are used to directly input channel number.
- 4.LIST:** Press to open the channels list.
- 5.**  Press this button to toggle between the current and the previous programme you were viewing
- 6.S.MODE:** Select the different sound mode directly.
- 7.SLEEP:** Set the sleep time.
- 8. MTS:** Press to select the MTS mode.(for example,Nicam , BTSC,MONO,STEREO .eg)
- 9.P.MODE:** Select the different picture mode directly.
- 10.MENU:** Start system menu and return to upper menu.
- 11.SOURCE:** Input source selection button.
- 12. ▲▼ ◀▶** Press ▼▲ button to select items.
Press ▶▶ button to adjust it.
- 13.ENTER:** To confirm the choice with the highlighted menu item.
- 14.EXIT:** Press to exit the OSD menu.
- 15.DISPLAY:** Press to display the source and channel's display.

Battery Installation:

Remove the battery compartment lid on the rear of the remote control by sliding the lid down, then off. Put two AAA batteries inside the battery compartment with their + and - ends aligned as indicated. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries. Refix the battery compartment lid. Slide the lid until you hear it click into place.

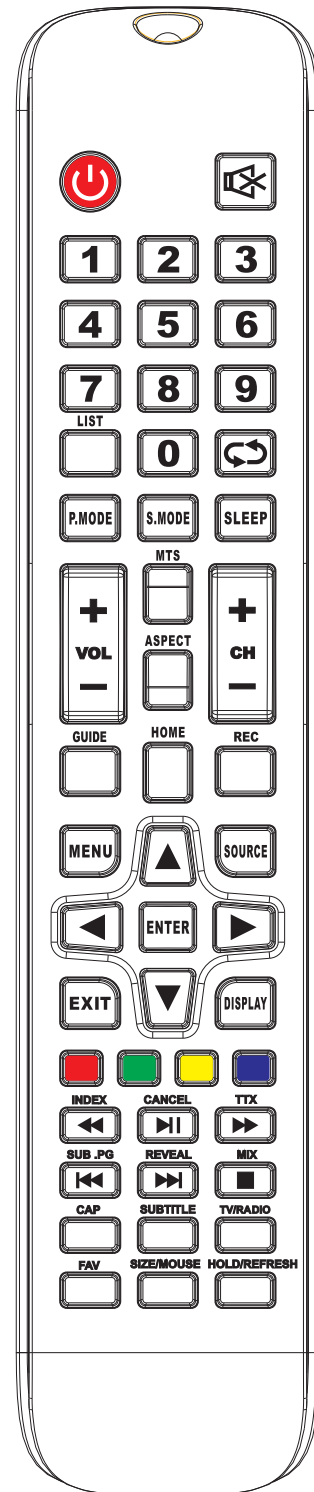
Using the Remote Control:

Unless stated otherwise, the remote control can operate all the features of the TV.

Always point the remote control directly at the remote sensor in the front of the TV.

CAUTION:

Batteries installed in the unit should not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire and the like.

Descriptions of television remote control

16.VOL+: Increase the volume.

17. REFRESH: Refresh page.

HOLD: HOLD On or Off for current page display .

18.VOL-: Decrease the volume.

19. CAP:A key to the current image is saved to the disk.

20.PLAY/PAUSE: Press to PLAY/PAUSE in the USB mode.
start play and PAUSE ,in USB mode.

CANCEL: When a page is selected in the mode of text, it may take some time before it becomes available, pressing the CANCEL key will return to the TV mode. When the required page is found , the page number will appear at the top of the TV picture, press the CANCELkey to return to the mode of text for you to browse this page.

21.TV/RADIO: When watching channel, allows you to switch between TV and Radio modes.

22.STOP: Press to STOP in the USB mode.

MIX: TV and TXT pictures are mixed together (transparent background)

23.GREEN/RED/YELLOW/CYAN button

24.CH+: Increase the program.

25.HOME: A key back to the android home page.

26.CH-: Decrease the program.

27. ASPECT: Aspect function.

28.MOUSE:Mouse switch.

SIZE: Change the size of display in Teletext mode.

29.SUBTITLE: To display subtitle in USB mode.

30. REC: Record begin in PVR mode.

31. GUIDE:Launches the EPG (Electronic Program Guide)

32. FAV:Press to add or remove your favorite channels under tv menu.

33. FF: Press to fast forward in USB mode.

TXT: Switch the teletext on and off.

34. PREV: Press to skip backwards in USB mode

SUB. PG: Press to access sub page.

35. FR: Press to fast reverse in USB mode.

INDEX: Request the Index page in Teletext mode.

36. NEXT: Press to skip forward in USB mode.

REVEAL: Reveal or Hide the hidden words.
