



- 1 Connect the antenna cable into the antenna input terminal at the rear panel and wall antenna socket.

- The type of power plug provided may be different from the above picture for some countries.







- 1. POWER button: turn the television on/switch it to stand-by mode

- 9. **LED indicator light**: shows the status of the device (green = on, red = stand-by mode)





- 5. **COAXIAL**: connect to a 5.1 audio system
- 6. HDMI: connect an AV device with a HDMI connector
- 7. USB: connect a USB device
- RF: connect a VHF/UHF antenna or an antenna cable
- ${f YPbPr}$ : connect to a DVD player, set-top-box or another AV device with component video output  ${f (YPbPr)}$
- 10. CI: connect a CI module

#### **PC Connection**


#### 1. Receiving PC Signal

To connect LED TV with PC, enjoy much clearer and more realistic video and audio.

#### Connect process:

- A. Make sure that booth units, TV set and your PC are switched Off.
- B. Connect D15 pins VGA plug to Computer VGA Video plug, and the other side of the cable connect to D15 VGA input plug of your TV set. Thighten and screws plugs.
- C. Connect TV and PC to power supply.
- D. Firstly switch on TV set, than switch on PC computer.
- E. Set up the input mode of the TV set on the PC RGB Mode through control panel on the unit cabinet or **SOURCE** button on the remote controller.
- F. Adjust Volume by **VOL+** or **VOL-** buttons through control panel on the unit cabinet or VOL button on the remote controller.
- G. TV set can sustain the pixel rates as presented in table form below. Please adjust correct resolution on your PC to adjust optimal quality of the picture.

### First Installation

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### **Auto Installation**

If this is the first time you are turning on the TV and there are no programs in the TV memory, the **Auto Installation** menu will appear on the screen. There are 6 setups as follow:

**Setup1**: Set up the Mode. Please select by the **Up/Down** buttons on the remote controller the Mode where you install your TV set and press **OK** button to confirm..



**Setup2**: Set up the Country. Please select by the **Up/Down** buttons on the remote controller the Country where you install your TV set and press **OK** button to confirm..




**Setup 3**: Set up language. Please select by the **Up/Down** buttons on the remote controller the Language and press **OK** button to confirm..






**Setup4**: Set up the Auto Power Off. Please select by the **Up/Down** buttons on the remote controller the Auto power Off time. In the case that no any comands in tuned time, TV set will automatically switch off. To switch off Auto Power Off time, choose **Off** or adjust desired time of Auto Switch off function



**Setup 5**: Set up TV Connection type. Please select by the **Up/Down** buttons on the remote Receiving Signal Type and press **OK** button to confirm.



Setup 6: Set up Auto Search Type. You can choose All programs search, only ATV (Analog TV) or DTV (Digital TV) programs. Please select by the Up/Down buttons on the remote Receiving Signal Type and press OK button to confirm.



Than, TV System will Search all frequency band and find all available TV programs, according to above setup.


All programs will be stored in the memory.

You can Edit all programs (Delete, Move, Swap, Skip, Lock etc...) additionally.


### Remote Control

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### **Installing The Remote Control Batteries**









- 1. Open the battery compartment cover on the remote control.
- 2. Insert 2x 1.5V AAA batteries in the right direction towards the polarity markings on the remote control
- 3. Replace the lid on the remote control slide in the opposite direction until you hear the sound of the lid.

If you long time will not use the remote control, remove the batteries to avoid possible damage caused by batteries leakage. The damage due to leaking batteries is not covered by warranty. The batteries shell not to be exposeed to excessive heat such as direct sunshine or fire.

Danger of explosion if battery is incorrectly replaced. Replace batteries only with the same or equivalent type.

Dispose batteries into recycling waste, according to the instructions. Do not drop the batteries into standard waste.

#### Working conditions

Point the remote control receiver to the LCD LED unit in the range of 30° left or right of the unit.

Infrared sensor will respond to remote control within the range of 7 meters

### Power On/ Off

#### Turning on the TV

- 1. Plug the TV's power cord into a wall outlet (after this step, the main unit will turn on and enter standby mode automatically).
- 2. Press the (Power) button on the TV, or press the (Power) button on the remote control. The TV will turn on.

### **Placing In Standby Mode**


Your TV can be placed in Standby mode in order to reduce the power consumption. The standby mode can be useful when you wish to interrupt viewing temporarily (during a meal, for example).


- 1. Press the Power button.
- 2. To switch back on, simply press power button.

Remark: Do not leave your TV in Standby mode for long periods of time. (when you are away on holiday, for example). It is the best to unplug the set from the mains and aerial.

### **Remote Control**

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Press the appropriate colour to direct access functions in TELETEXT,
 GUIDE mode.

### **Remote Control**

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P.MODE Selects picture mode

Displays the main index in Teletext mode.

S.MODE Selects sound effect options

Reveals hidden information such as the answer to a quiz in TELETEXT mode.

P.SIZE Cycles through Wide mode settings

Displays the top, bottom or all of page,

**SUBTITLE** Displays the subtitle menu on the screen in DTV mode, use ▲▼ to select the TV subtitle options.

Freeze a multi-page passage on screen in Teletext mode.

**REC** In DTV mode, Press REC button to start recording, press ■ button to stop recording

TIME SHIFTIN DTV mode. Click in the DTV mode key to start the delay function, press the play button to start playing delay program, press the key to terminate the delay functions.

In Media mode, press to start playback or pause.

■ In Media mode, press to stop playback, track, chapter or track.

TEXT Turns on and off the Teletext function.

**PVR LIST** In DTV mode, displays the executed PVR LIST and Index

playback rapidly.

FAV.CH Pressing FAV.CH displays favorites.

■ In Media mode, press to jump to the previous of the currently played chapter or track.

**GUIDE** Displays the Programme Guide on the screen in DTV mode. Pressing again to turn GUIDE off.

► In Media mode, press to jump to the next of the currently played chapter or track.

### **Changing Programmes**

## Using the programme selection buttons on the remote control to change programmes

To select a programme, press the corresponding programme selection button on the remote control. For example, to select programme 8, press the "8" programme selection button on the remote control.

#### Using the CH+/- buttons to sequentially change programmes

Press CH+/- buttons on the remote control or on the TV to sequentially select the TV programmes available in you area.

#### Using the 🖒 button to return to the previous programme

To return to the previous viewed programme, press the 😉 button on the remote control.

#### Power On/Off

#### To turn on the TV

1 Connect the power play into the wall outlet.

The power indicator lights in red, indicating that the TV is in standby mode.

2 Press 🖰

The power indicator lights turns off and the TV turns on.

#### To turn off the TV

Press ()

The power indicator lights in red and the TV turns off to standby mode.



- It takes approximately 10 seconds for the picture to appear after the TV is turned on.
  - The TV will switch to standby mode automatically if there is no signal input for 10 minutes.
  - If the TV will not be used for a long periods of time, unplug the TV from the wall outlet.

#### Basic operations of OSD menu

Press "MENU" button on the TV set or Remote control to display the Main OSD Menu as below:

#### Volume Adjustment

#### To change the volume

- 1 Press V+ to increase the sound volume.
- 2 Press V- to decrease the sound volume.

#### To mute the sound

- 1 Press 🗱 to temporarily turn off the sound.
- You can decrease the sound volume by pressing V- while the sound is muted.


#### **Input Source Select**

#### To select input

Press **SOURCE** button on the TV set or Remote control to display the input source menu.

- Press CH+/- or ▲/▼ to select the input source.
- 2 Press OK button to confirm choosen input source
- Before you select the input source, make sure the connections are prepared.





Press ▲/▼ button to select the Main Menu, than press ▶/OK button to enter the Submenu.

In Submenu, press ▲/▼ button to select the Item, than press ▶/OK button to enter into adjust and press ◄/▶ button to adjust item.

Press **MENU** or **◀** button to return to the previous Menu.


Press **EXIT** button to exit from Menu Display.

Note: Only when you input suitable Source, the relevant items can be activated.

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### **Picture Setting**



Picture Mode: Select your desired picture mode. You can set: Dynamic, Standard, Mild and User.

**Brightness:** Adjust image Black level (brightness).

Contrast: Adjust image Contrast.

**Sharpness:** Adjust the Sharpness (only in DTV, ATV, YPbPr, AV and SCART mode)

Colour: Adjust image color

Tint: Adjust image tint (only available in NTSC picture mode)

**Colour Temp:** Select an optimum color temperature mode to your eyes and room conditions. You can set:

Standard, Cool and Warm.

**Aspect:** Change the aspect for the screen from Auto, 4:3, 16:9, Full, Zoom1.

Noise Reduction: To reduce noise and improve the appearance of the picture. You can set option from Low-

>Middle->High, noise reduction effects better picture but it will cause a blur on picture.



### **Sound Setting**



Sound Mode: Select your desired sound mode. You can set: Standard, Movie, Music, Speech and User

sound mode.

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Bass: Adjust the level of the bass sound.

Treble: Adjust the level of treble sound.

**Balance:** Adjust the Audio output balance between left and right speakers.

**Surround:** Turn On/Off the Surround sound effect.

Auto Volume Level: The volume of the audio sources or TV programs will be automatically equalized to

approximately the same audio level

SPDIF: Select the SPDIF (Digital Audio) mode. You can select: Off, PCM or Auto.



### Channel Menu (ATV, DTV mode)



#### **Channel Managment**

Enter the Channel managment menu to edit the channels (Delete/Rename/Swap/Lock/Skip).

Note: You have to enter the Password (Lock Password in Feature menu) if you want to edit the channels.



**RED button:** Press **RED** button to sign the channel you want to delete.

GREEN button: To Lock or Unlock channel.

To watch a locked channel the system will required to enter the password after you switch on Lock function in Lock-Lock Channel Menu in the Feature menu..

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YELLOW button: Skip the channel or skip setting cancel.

When option skip is enabled, then the channel will be skipped by using the button **CH+/-.** Direct access to the desired channel is always possible with numeric enter by remote.

BLUE button: Swap the position of the channels. Sign the channel by pressing BLUE button, move

signed channel by pressing A/V buttons and press OK button to swap position.


Press **OK** button to enter the Rename menu to rename the ATV channel. DTV channel renaimeing is not possible.

#### **Favorite Managment**

Add or Remove channels into FAV lists by the corespondings color buttons.

Up to 4 Favorite lists are available, RED-FAV1, GREEN-FAV2, YELLOW-FAV3, BLUE-FAV4,

Note: You could display Favourite lists 1/2/3/4 by press the FAV button once / twice / three times / four times.



#### Country

Select the Country where you install your TV set.

#### **Auto Search**

**Note:** When the Child Lock is Active, please enter the Password (Lock Password in Feature menu) to start Auto and Manual Search

Press **OK** button to enter the Auto Search menu, select search mode and press **OK** button to start with Auto search function.



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#### Note:

1. ALL: Auto search all channels (ATV+DTV+Radio)

DTV: Auto search for DTV and Radio channels only.


ATV: Auto search for ATV channels only.

2. When the TV is in Auto Search mode, you could press **MENU** button to Stop Auto Search function and return to previous Menu,

#### **Digital DTV Manual Search**

Enter the DTV Manual Search menu.

Press ▲/▼ button to select the Channel item and press **OK** /▶ button to select the channel. Than press ▲/▼ button to select the **START** item and press **OK** /▶ button to start with Manual Search function.



#### **Analog ATV Manual Search**

Enter the ATV Manual Search menu.



Current Channel: Select the current channel for manual search.

Search: Press OK button to enter the search menu, and manual search the frequency by the

button.

Fine Tune: Press OK button to enter the Fine Tune menu, and fine tune the frequency by pressing

✓/ button.

Color/Sound System: Select the Color / Sound system for the program.

#### LCN On/Off

It is the channel sort method. LCN Function enable user presentation of services number in a convenient and familiar form. Enter the DTV Manual Search menu.




### **Feature Menu**



#### Lock

This Menu allows you to Lock certain features of the TV, so that they can not be used or viewed. For example, if you don't want certain channels viewed by children or if the TV set is to be used in the Hotel and you want to lock certain channels or Menues.

When you enter to the system lock, you will be asked for a password. Default Password is "0 0 0 0".



Lock Enable: Turn On/Off Lock functions.

**Note:** When option is turned on, the functions or Parental Guidence and Change Pin Code will be locked. Functions Lock (in Channel Menagment), Auto Search, DTV and ATV Manual Search in Channel Menu will be locked also.

Parental Guidence: Select the Parental Guidence Level or Turn Off function.

**Change Pin Code:** Press OK button to enter, first enter the current code, than enter your new code and confim your new code once again.

#### MADTA

#### Language

This Menu allows you to adjust Language of the System and other language Setups.

To enter into Menu press **OK** or ▶ button.

#### Clock

This Menu allows you to adjust Clock Setup, Date, Time Zone and DST option (summer time).

To enter into Menu press **OK** or **▶** button.

#### Sleep Timer

This Menu allows you to adjust Sleep Timer. You can adjust time counter to autonatic switch-off the unit from 10mins to 240mins.

To enter into Menu press **OK** or **▶** button.

#### **Auto Power Off**

This Menu allows you to adjust Auto Power Off function. This means that if at the adjusted item time is not pressed by any command on the remote or the controls on the cabinet, the TV set will automatically switch off. Function can be set up on hours (1hour, 2hours, 4 hours) of work time or turn it off.

To enter into Menu press **OK** or **▶** button.

#### Hearing Impaired

This Menu allows you to adjust Hearing Impaired function. If Broadcsater transmit Hearing Impaired Service, this function offers a subtitle such as a "stroke on the door" or "the bell starts to ring" for the current scene in case that the user is weak in hearing.

To enter into Menu press **OK** or **▶** button.

#### CUInfo

This Menu display main information about CI Card (if CI Card is connected)

To enter into Menu press OK or ▶ button.

#### PVR/TimeShift



#### Standard Recording

To start Record Channel, please press REC key.

it will pop up a message "Do you want to start Recording?". After confirm, the system will read the speed of the storage device. If the speed is too low for recording, there is a message "Device speed not enough, RECORD anyway?" if user choose Yes, it will record constrainedly. In addition, the speed is high enough, it initializes in the first instance and starts to record later.



As the initialization successfully ends, a REC input info menu appears on the right top corner of the picture and it starts to record while the program is playing in the background.

#### MADTA

Press **INFO** key to get the current recording information from the Info Banner, such as current recording time and the recording progress. The recording time depends on how much of the program has been recorded actually.

The recording progress will stop when the USB device has no more free spaces if there is no setting about when to end before. A warning massage pops up, the recording process stops and it will keep on the normal playback process. Otherwise the progress ends naturally when the timer is timeout. Also user could press **STOP** key to end recording manually.

#### **EPG Recording:**

In the **EPG Menu** you can preengage Programs for watching or Recording.

In EPG menu, Press **GREEN** key for activate **Reminder** of highlated program, or press **GREEN** key **Twice** to activate **TimerRecord** function.

Reminder mode: when timeout is reached, unit automatically jumps to the program and only play

**TimerRecord mode**: when timeout is reached, unit automatically jumps to the program and starts recording. If it is timeout in standby mode, it will power on 2 minutes in advance and starts to record under background, without powering on the panel. To watch the program, user need to press **POWER** key.

#### **Edit EPG Recording**

In Timer menu, you can Increase. Delete or Edit preengage programs.

In the Timer Menu, press YELOW button to Add or BLUE key to Edit Timer.

When the timer recorder is timeout, it jumps to the very channel and starts to record the program automatically (if a manual recording is under process, it will stop the manual recording process and starts the timer recorder automatically). When there is left 10s before recorder, a prompted window will pops up:





#### **TimeShift**

Timeshift can record program and play the current recording program at the same time. You can paused watching program (for example when telephone ringing) and after finsih your telephone talk, you can continue to watch paused program.

To activate TimeShift, please keep plug in USB storage Device and Set TimeShift Buffer in PVR / TimeShift menu. TimeShift Buffer means how long a recorder can be stored when TimeShift is active. If Buffer is overstepped, the previous recorder stored there will be lie over; There are three modes: Auto, 30Mins, 1h, 2hr. Auto means that Time Shift will use all the free spaces on the storage media.

#### Activate Time Shift

In the normal playback process in DTV source, there are two ways to start timeshift:

Manually: Press **PAUSE** to start Timeshift when there is no menu focused ( Stop: Press **STOP** key.

2. Automatically: Set the Auto Timeshift option as Auto in

PVR/TimeShift Menu.

To stop set Auto TimeShift as Off.

Before Manually Timeshift, there is a message "Do you want to start Timeshift". After confirm, it will check whether the speed of the storage device that the user inserted is enough for Timeshift. If the speed is not enough, a warning message will pop up to let the user make decision whether to go on. If timeshift is force to take place, there may be some pause or mosaic. Fast Forward ← A playing video can move fast forward or backward with the speed: x2, x4, x8, x16 or Play in a nomal speed.

Previous ► When a video playing, it can jump to the previous or the next video to play by pressing the buttons.

#### Restrictions

#### Device & File System

The USB host supports version 2.0 and is compatible with version 1.1, but it can't support card reader and USB Hub, neither Timeshift and timer recorder on USB 1.1.

Support Timeshift on programs which have a equal or lower rate than 8Mbps and support recorder on programs which have a equal or lower rate than 13Mbps (13Mbps is a test result of SAM USB2,0 High speed 320G.

#### Restrictions on USB device for Recorder

For programs which have a lower rate than 8Mbps, the USB device must have a rate higher than 14Mbps for Recorder and higher than 28Mbps for Timeshift. Otherwise there may be some pause or mosaic when do Recorder or Timeshift by force.

For programs which have a higher rate than 8Mbps, the USB device must have a rate higher than 20Mbps for Recorder and Timeshift is not supported. Otherwise there may be some pause or mosaic when do Recorder or Timeshift by force.

The USB device's file system supports FAT32 / FAT/NTFS.

The system supports 4 partition connection at most at the same time. The same partition is able to store 9999 recorded files at most, namely the biggest number of files is 9999. The maximum size of a single file the system supports is 4GB at present, When long "time recording" the file will be cut to creat a new one automatically when its size reaches 3.9GB.

The system can support USB flashdisk and removable disk at present. However, it can not sure that all kinds of them could record or write into the storage very smoothly, especially when the file system is in disorder. If users are opt to use a USB flashdisk as the storage media, it is recommended to format the disk before use.
